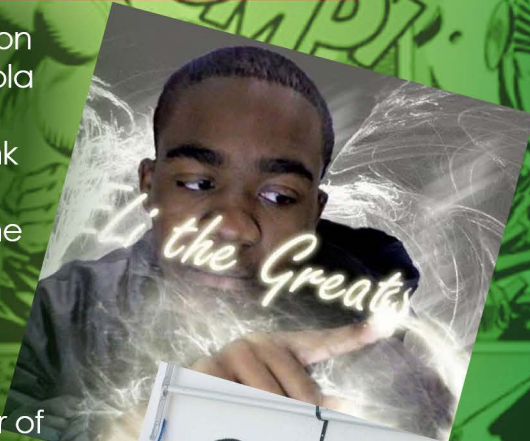
Elijah was to be married to Jalyne Goss. He was employed by Florida Transcor, Inc., and he was also the Owner and Operator of Fable Tees.
