HIS LIFE & LEGACY

Simon Cull was born on March 11, 1948 in Donaldsonville, Georgia to the late Cornelius and Tink Cull. Simon was raised by his aunt, Lizzie Smith at the age of one following the death of his mother.

He accepted Jesus Christ at an early age, although prior to Death he did not have a church home but worshiped regularly at St. Nicholas Bethel Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Richard Jackson and Rev. Andrew Sims.

He attended Mathew W. Gilbert graduating in the class of 1966.

A Vietnam Veteran, he enlisted in the United States Marines where he served his country faithfully from 1967 to 1970 before being Honorably Discharge. Simon furthered his education attending Edwards Waters (College) University earning a degree in Bachelor of Arts in Sociology in 1988. He was employed with The United States Postal Service for 25 years before retiring in 2003.

On November 4, 1996 in Jacksonville, Florida he was united in Holy Matrimony to the former Gwendolyn McCrary Smith. He was preceded in death by his mother and father, Aunt Lizzie Smith, 7 brothers, 2 sisters and 2 sons Vashawn and Gervone Cull.
