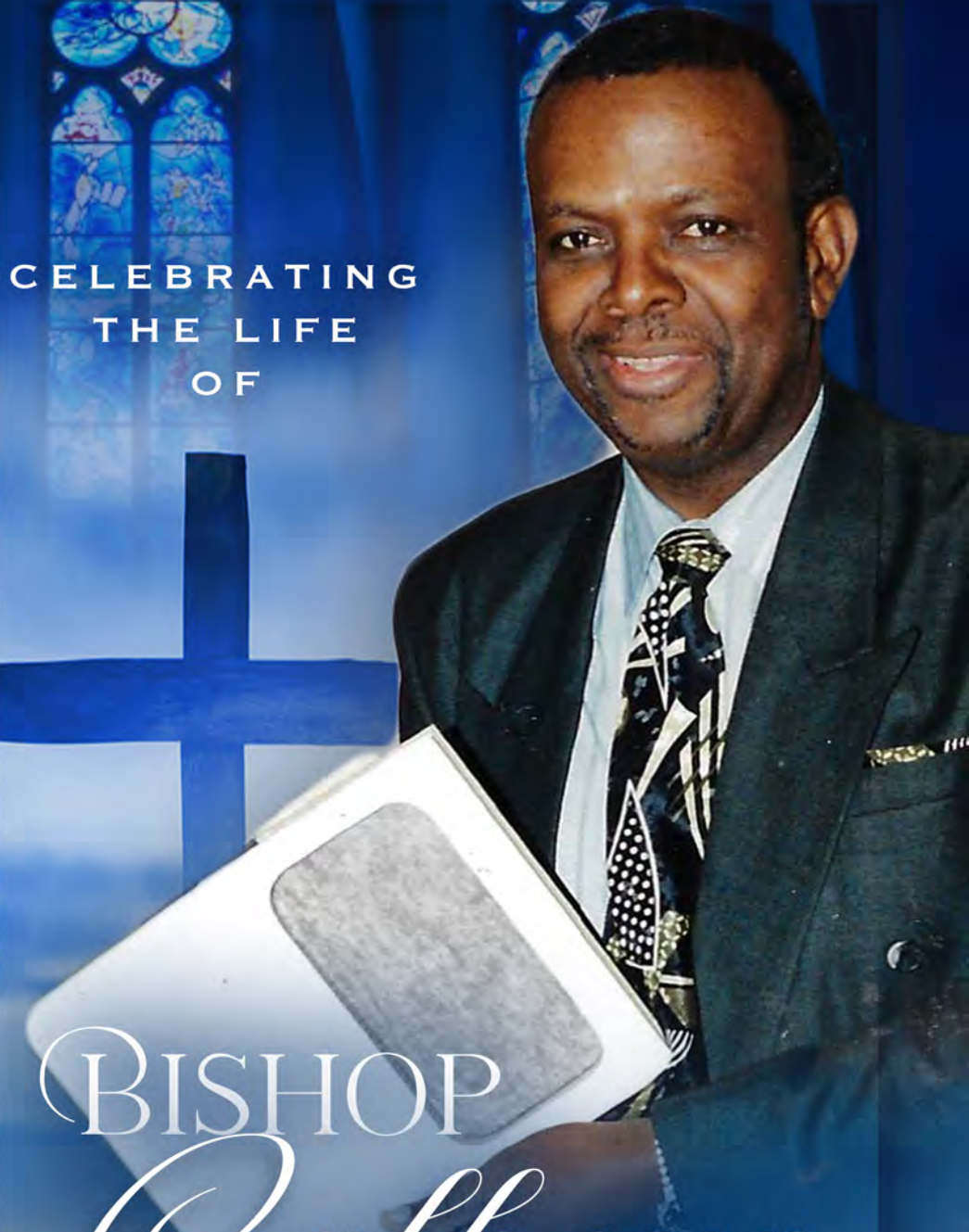

HIS STORY

CALHOUN JAMES WILLIAMS, III, was born April 24, 1938, in Denmark, South Carolina. He was born to the late Deacon Calhoun James Williams and Overseer Hattie Mae Williams.

He began his Christian journey at a youthful age. Bishop Williams accepted the calling of God on his life and became a Jr. Deacon, from a Jr. Deacon to a Deacon, from a Deacon to a Minister, a Minister to an Evangelist, from an Evangelist to an Assistant-Pastor; all under the ordination of Overseer Hattie Mae Williams of the New Apostolic Shiloh Holiness Church Jacksonville, Florida. Under this Ministry he served side by side with his mother, as the Sunday School Superintendent/Teacher, Secretary, Usher, whatever his hands found to do; he did it in. He continued to spread the Word of God while working with the saints. He worked with a number of ministries through the years, leading souls to Christ as a traveling Evangelist was his mission. He loved people and was loved by many. One of his favorite saying was, "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!" Psalm 133:1. As years past he accepted the call of Pastorship and Founded Rock Deliverance Church for All People. He later was ordained to the office of a Bishop by the late Bishop James Brant. He continued to work in his calling until his health failed him.

On June 11, 1966, Bishop Calhoun J. Williams, III, married his "Sweet Thing", best friend and the love of his life, the late Dr. Gloria F. Williams. They worked side by side in the LORD. He was the "Spiritual Father" to Rock Deliverance Church for All People.

Bishop Williams attended Duval Public Schools and graduated from New Stanton Preparatory School January 2, 1956. Higher education: Formerly Edward Waters College now Edward Waters University, Jones College, Florida Agriculture and Mechanical University, and Jacksonville Theological Seminary.

After retiring from General Motors, Bishop continued working as an entrepreneur. In the mid-90s he along with his wife co-founded Rock Deliverance Christian Academy. Where he continued his ministry by educating the youth. He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, pastor, and much more.

He was preceded in death by his parents: Deacon Calhoun and Overseer Hattie Mae Williams, wife: Dr. Gloria F. Williams, and daughter: Kynthia Williams.

He leaves to cherish his memory, a **son**- Travis J.
