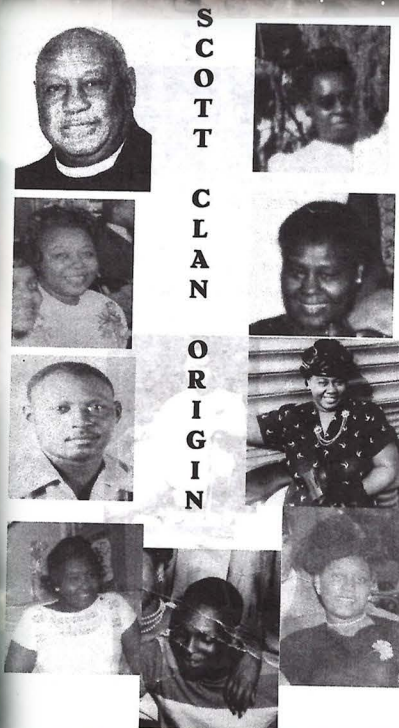


EUGENE MATTHEWS, SR.
