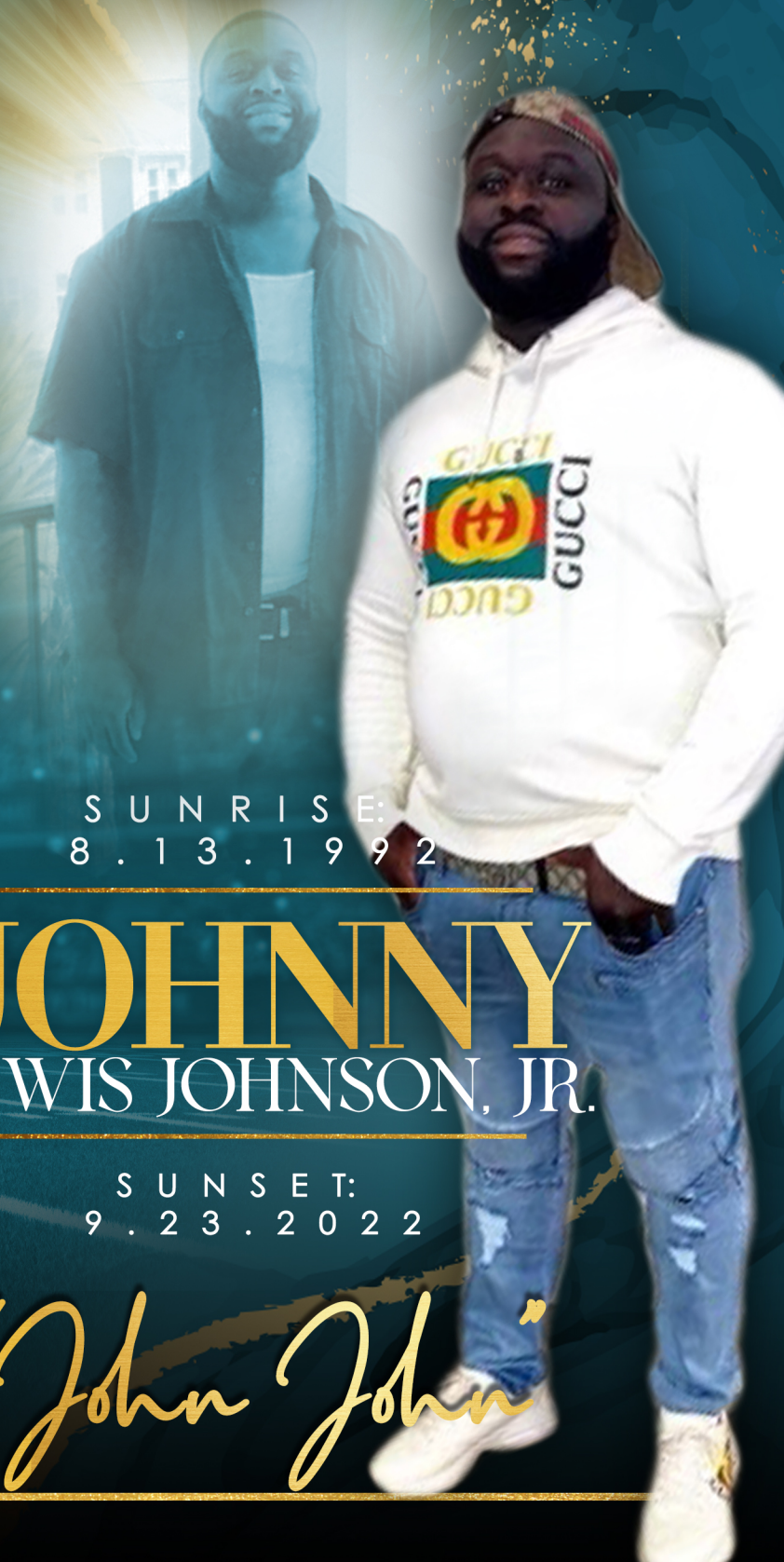

LIFE STORY

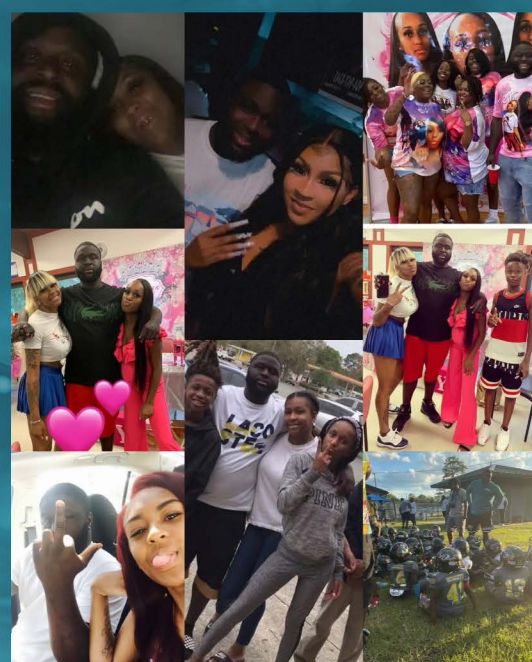
