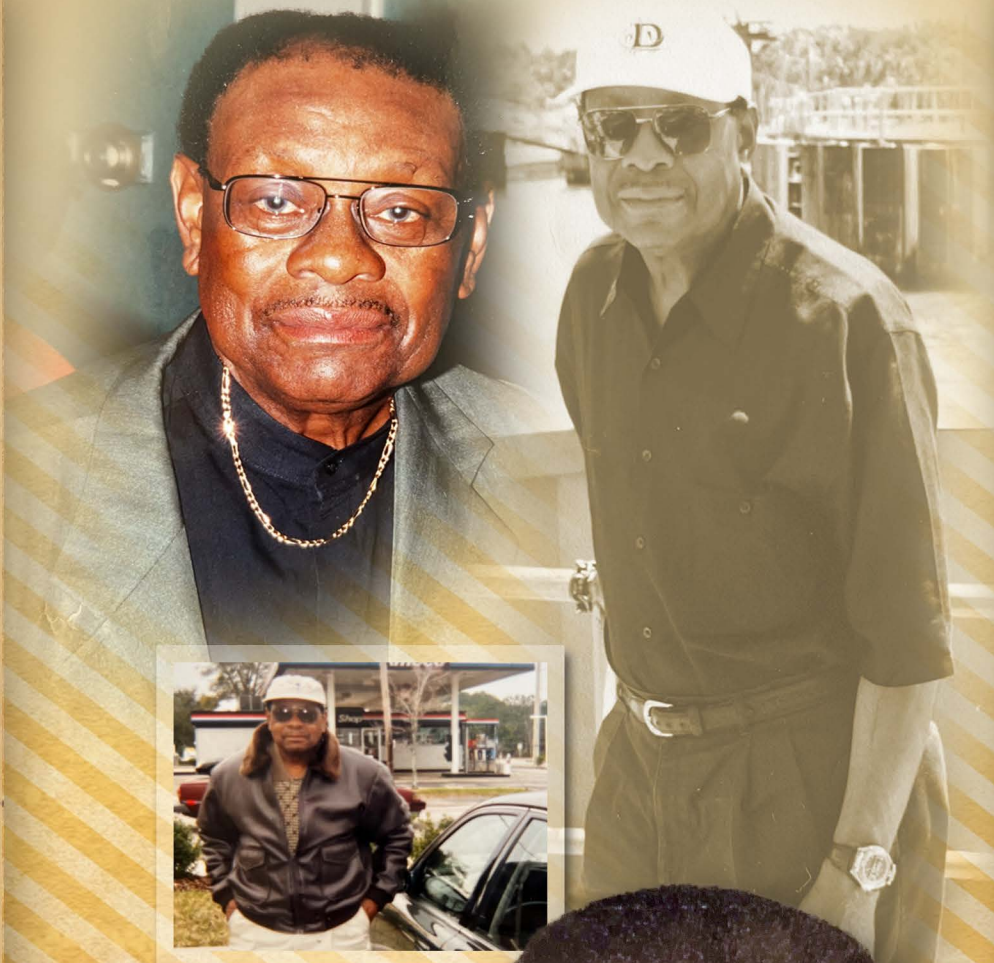
LIFE STORY
