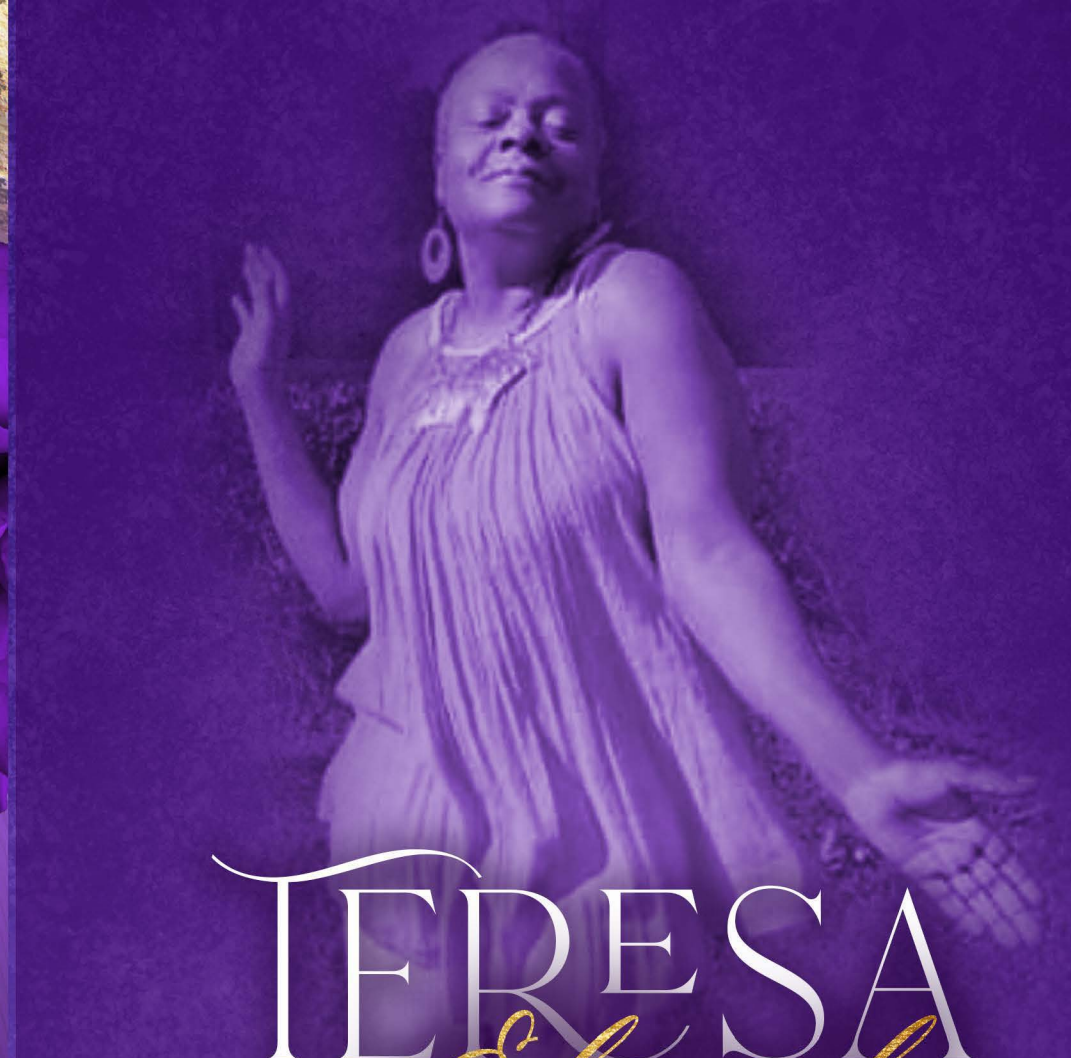




### "I'M FREE"
