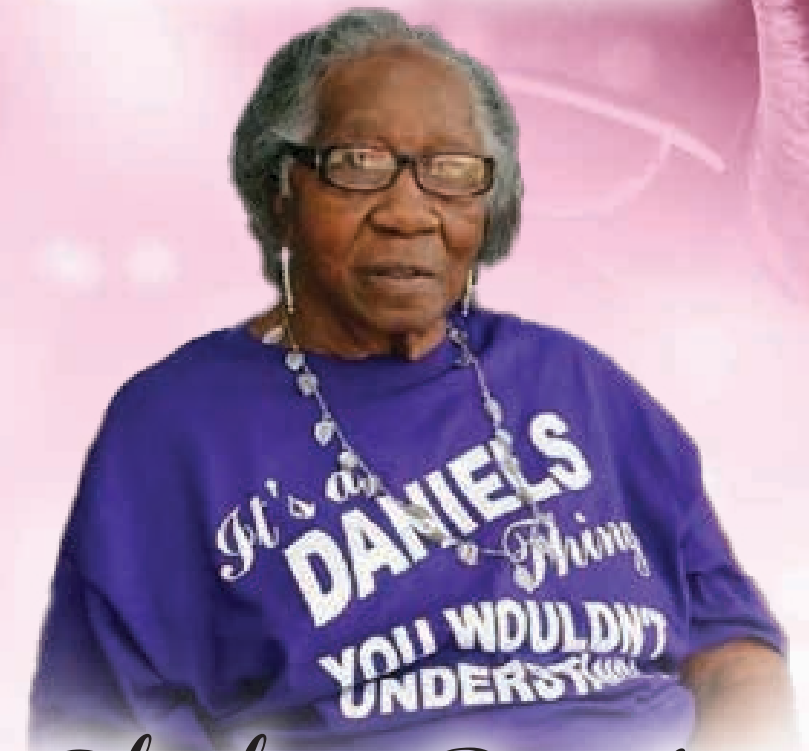

On May 9, 1935, the late Jessie Kate Buckles and the late Clark Daniels gave birth to a warrior, Ms. Gladys Daniels, but known to all as "Rooster".
