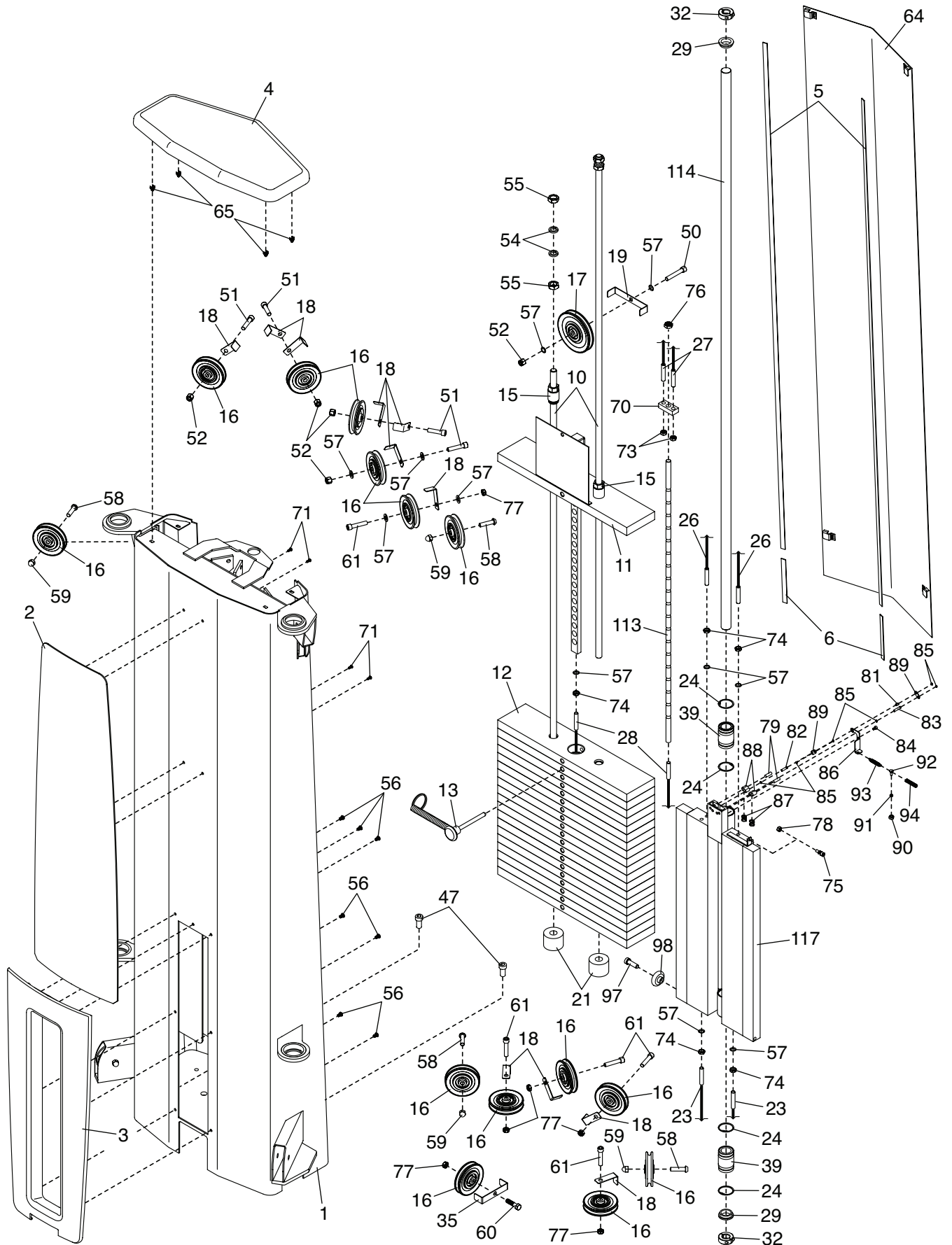


# EXPLODED DRAWING A

This exploded perspective view illustrates the assembly of a medical device, likely a catheter or probe. The main components are shown in their relative positions, with dashed lines indicating the assembly path. Key parts include:
