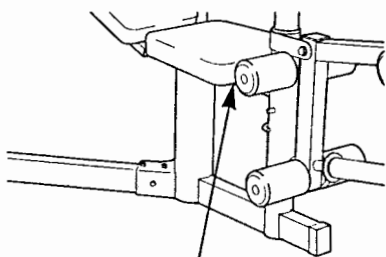

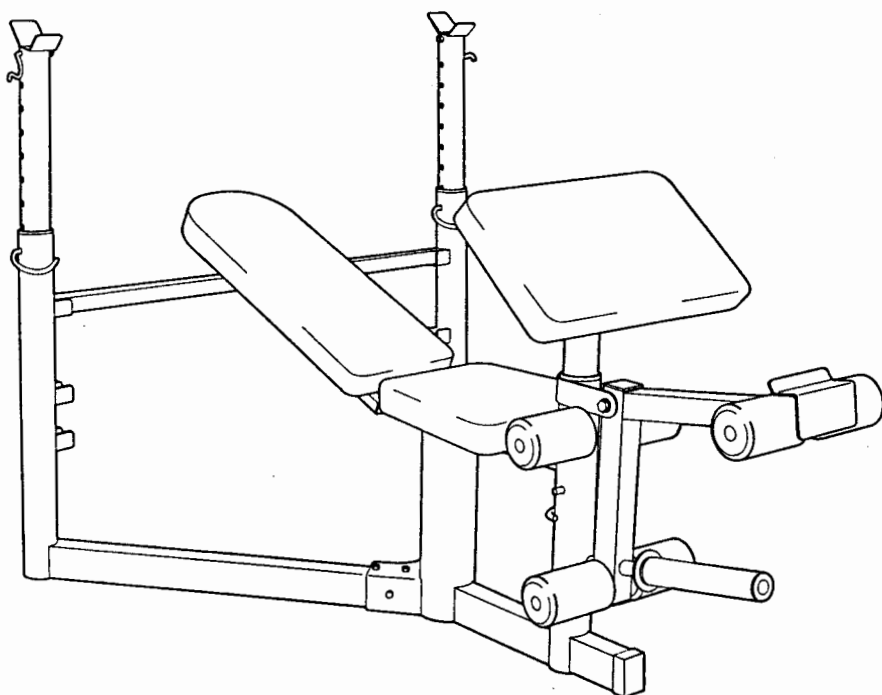

1. Read all instructions in this manual before using the weight bench.
2. Use the weight bench only on a level surface. Cover the floor beneath the weight bench for protection.
3. Inspect and tighten all parts regularly. Replace any worn parts immediately.
4. Keep small children and pets away from the weight bench at all times.
5. Do not place more than 365 pounds on the weight rests; do not place more than 150 pounds on the leg lever.
6. Always wear athletic shoes for foot protection when exercising.
7. Keep hands and feet away from moving parts.
8. The weight bench is designed to be used by only one person at a time.
9. If you feel pain or dizziness at any time while exercising, stop immediately and begin cooling down.
10. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that all users of the weight bench are adequately informed of all precautions.

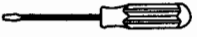
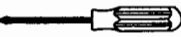
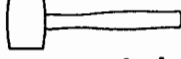
ASSEMBLY

Before beginning assembly, carefully read the following information and instructions:

- Place all parts of the IMAGE® 3.0 in a cleared area and remove the packing materials; do not dispose of the packing materials until assembly is completed.
- For help identifying the small parts used in assembly, use the PART IDENTIFICATION CHART located in the center of this manual. Note: Some small parts may have been pre-attached for shipping. If a part is not in the parts bag, check to see if it has been pre-attached.
- As you assemble the IMAGE® 3.0, be sure that all parts are oriented as shown in the drawings.

- Tighten all parts as you assemble them, unless instructed to do otherwise.

THE FOLLOWING TOOLS (NOT INCLUDED) ARE REQUIRED FOR ASSEMBLY:

- **Two (2) adjustable wrenches** 
- **One (1) standard screwdriver** 
- **One (1) phillips screwdriver** 
- **One (1) rubber mallet** 
- **Lubricant, such as grease or petroleum jelly, and soapy water will also be needed.**

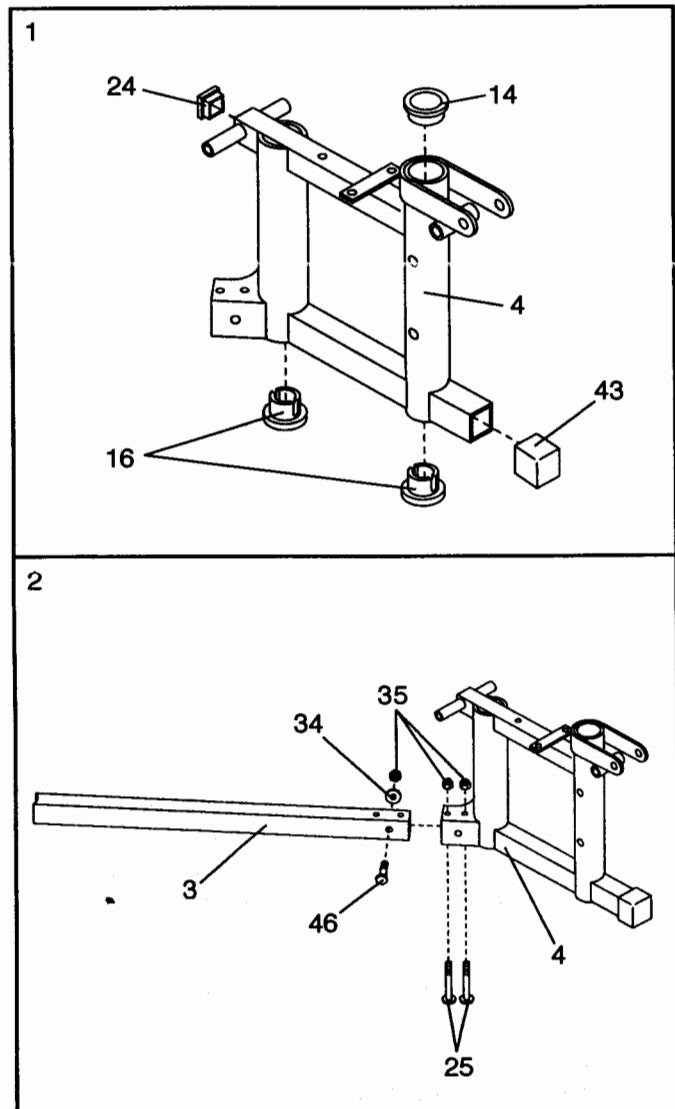
Assembly will be more convenient if you have the following tools: A socket set, a set of open-end or closed-end wrenches, or a set of ratchet wrenches.

1. **Before beginning assembly, be sure that you have read and understand the information in the box above.**

Press a 3" Plastic Bushing (14) in the top of the Frame (4). Press two 3" Slotted Endcaps (16) into the bottom of the Frame. Press a 2" x 3" Endcap (43) onto the lower end of the Frame. Press a 2" Square Endcap (24) into the back of the Frame.

2. Attach a Stabilizer (3) to the Frame (4) with two 3/8" x 3 3/4" Carriage Bolts (25) and two 3/8" Nylon Locknuts (35). **Do not tighten the Nylon Locknuts yet.** Insert a 3/8" x 3" Bolt (46) through the indicated hole in the Frame. Tighten a 3/8" Nylon Locknut (35), with a 3/8" Washer (34), onto the Bolt. **Tighten the other two Nylon Locknuts.**

Attach the other Stabilizer (3) to the Frame (4) in the same manner.



3. Attach the Left Upright (2) to the indicated Stabilizer (3) with two 3/8" x 4" Bolts (25) and two 1/2" x 2 3/4" Spacers (39). **Note the position of the adjustment brackets to identify the Left Upright.**

Press a 3" Endcap (16) into the bottom of the Left Upright (2).

Attach the Right Upright (not shown) to the other Stabilizer (3) in the same manner.

4. Insert a Barbell Lock Pin (38) through the top hole in a Weight Rest (1). Tighten a 3/8" Nylon Locknut (35) onto the Barbell Lock pin.

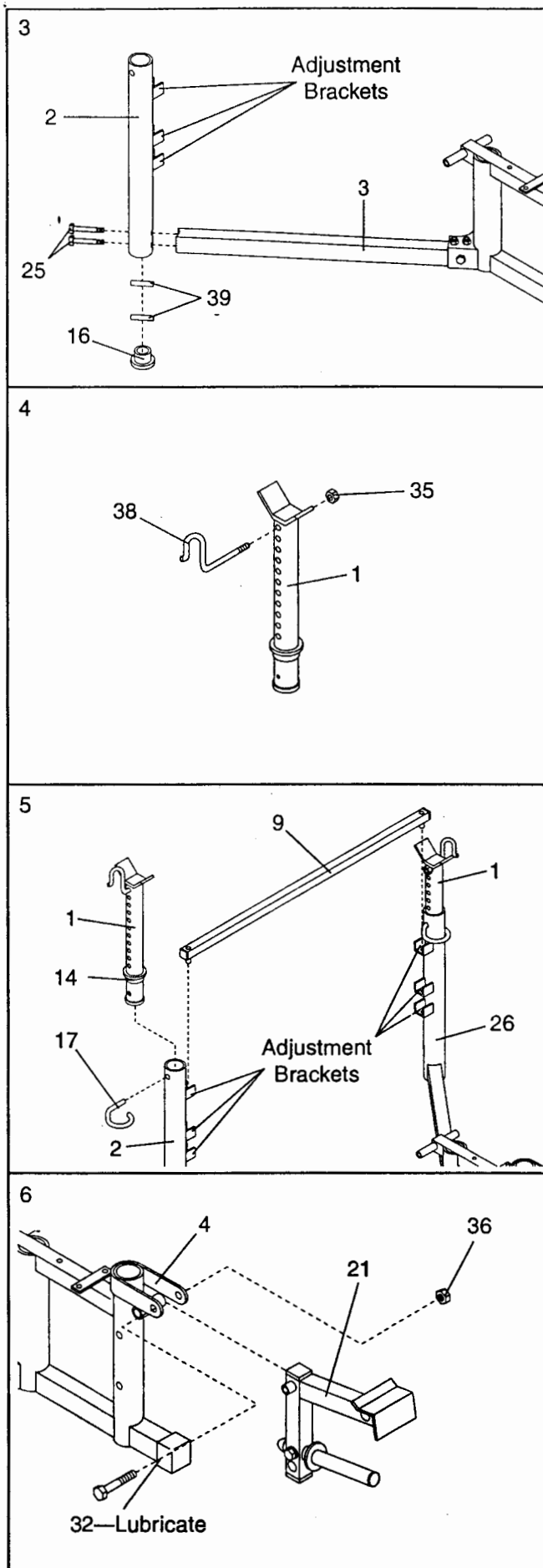
Attach the other Barbell Lock Pin (38) to the other Weight Rest (1) in the same manner.

5. Set the Adjustment Tube (9) into one set of adjustment brackets on the Left and Right Uprights (2, 26).

Insert a Weight Rest (1) into the Left Upright (2). **Be sure that the 3" Plastic Bushing (14) is firmly inserted into the top of the Upright.** Insert an Adjustment Pin (17) through the holes in the Left Upright (2) and the Weight Rest (1).

Attach the other Weight Rest (1) to the Right Upright (26) in the same manner. Be sure that both Weight Rests are at the same height.

6. Lubricate the 1/2" x 4" Bolt (32). Attach the Leg Lever (21) to the Frame with the 1/2" x 4" Bolt and the 1/2" Nylon Locknut (36).



7. Attach the Backrest Rails (10) to the Backrest (8) with four 1/4" x 1 1/2" Bolts (27). **Do not tighten the Bolts yet. Make sure that the Backrest Rails are turned so the indicated holes are at the ends shown.**

Attach the Backrest Rails (10) to the tube on the Frame (4) with a 3/8" x 7 1/2" Bolt (30) and a 3/8" Nylon Locknut (35). **Do not overtighten the Nylon Locknut.**

Tighten the four 1/4" x 1 1/2" Bolts (27).

8. Attach the Seat (7) to the Frame (4) with two 1/4" x 3/4" Bolts (29) and one 1/4" x 2 1/2" Bolt (41).

9. Attach the Leg Lever Lock Pin (37) to the indicated hole in the Frame (4) with a 3/8" Nylon Locknut (35).

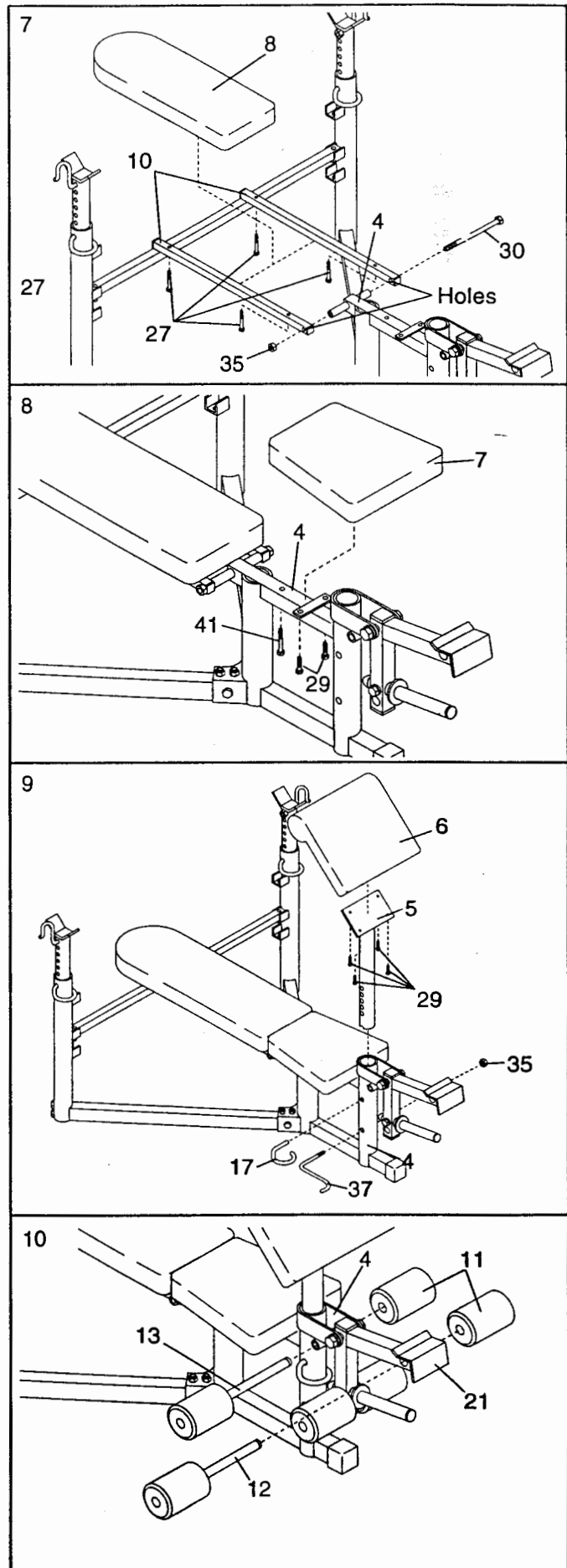
Attach the Preacher Curl Pad (6) to the Curl Post (5) with four 1/4" x 3/4" Bolts (29).

Insert the Curl Post (5) into the Frame (4). Align one set of holes in the Curl Post with the holes in the Frame (4). Insert an Adjustment Pin (17) through the Curl Post and the Frame.

10. **Note: The parts shown in this step may have been pre-assembled for shipping purposes. Be sure that all parts are securely in place.**

Insert the 15" Pad Tube (13) into the Frame (4). Slide a Foam Pad (11) onto the end of the Pad Tube.

Insert the two 14" Pad Tubes (12) into the Leg Lever (21). Slide a Foam Pad (11) onto the end of each 14" Pad Tube.



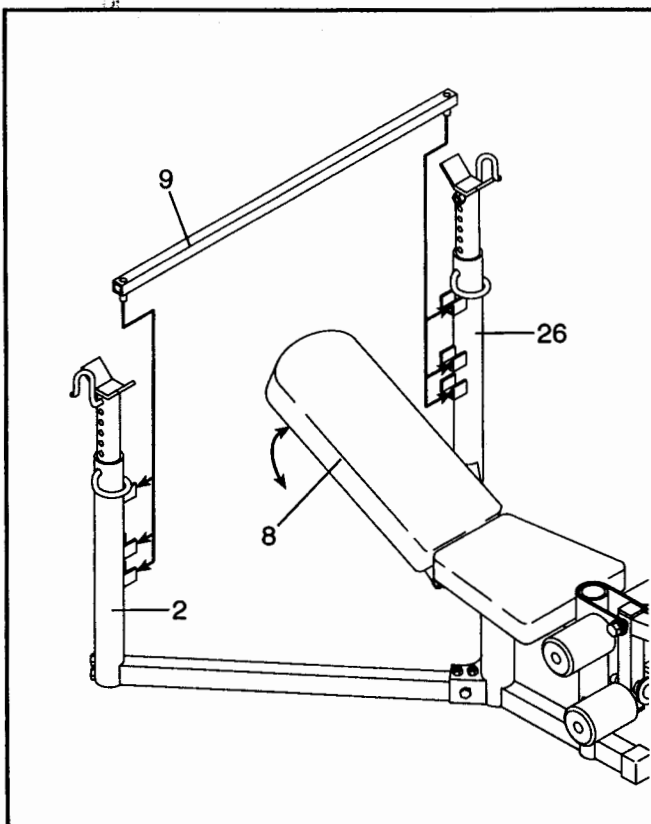
HOW TO ADJUST THE IMAGE® 3.0

The instructions below describe how each part of the IMAGE® 3.0 can be adjusted. Refer to the exercise information accompanying your weight set (not included) to see the correct form for each exercise.

ADJUSTING THE BACKREST

The Backrest (8) has three different positions: a level position, a decline position, and an incline position.

To change the position of the Backrest (8), move the Adjustment Bar (9) to a different set of adjustment brackets on the Left and Right Uprights (2, 26). **Make sure that the adjustment bar is securely seated in the adjustment brackets.**

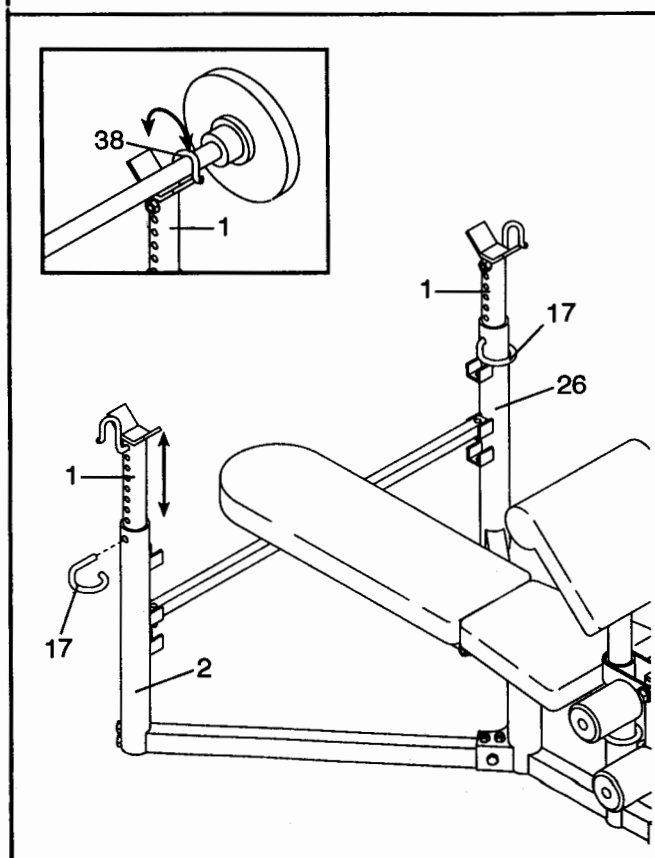


ADJUSTING THE WEIGHT RESTS

To change the height of the Weight Rests (1), first remove your barbell from the Weight Rests. Remove the Adjustment Pin (17) from the Weight Rest in the Left Upright (2). Position the Weight Rest at the desired height. Align the holes in the Weight Rest with the holes in the Upright. Re-insert the Adjustment Pin.

Position the Weight Rest (1) in the Right Upright (26) at the same height.

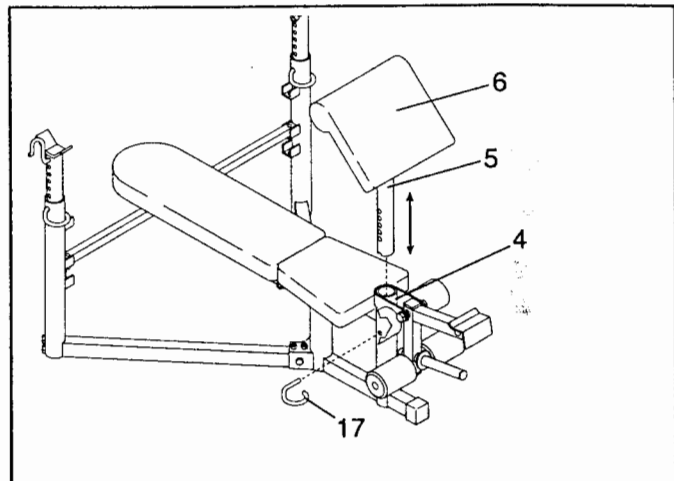
See the inset drawing. To change weights while your barbell (not included) is on the Weight Rests (1), secure your barbell with the Barbell Lock Pins (38). This will reduce the possibility of the barbell tipping while you change weights. **Place the same amount of weight on both ends of the barbell.**



ATTACHING THE PREACHER CURL PAD

For some exercises, the Preacher Curl Pad (6) must be attached to the weight bench.

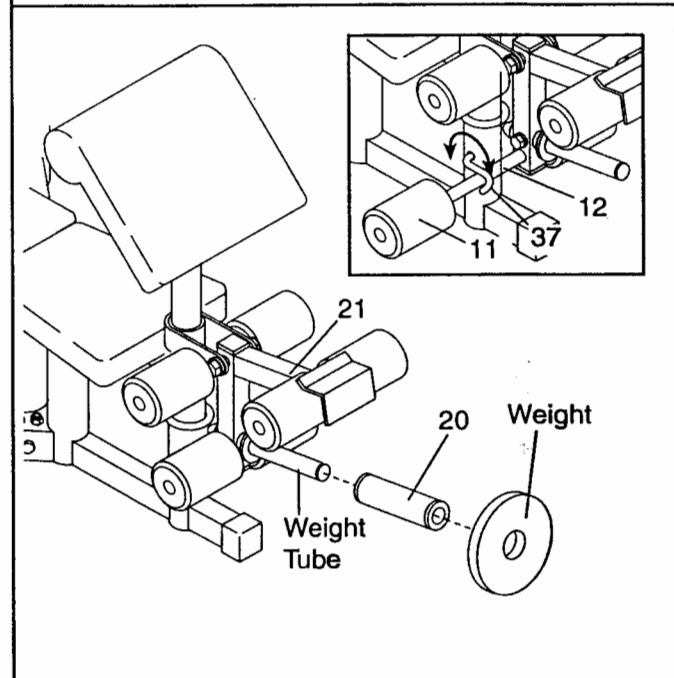
Insert the Curl Post (5) into the indicated hole in the Frame (4). Position the Curl Post at the desired height. Align the holes in the Frame with the holes in the Curl Post. Insert an Adjustment Pin (17).



USING THE LEG LEVER

To use the Leg Lever (21), slide the desired amount of weight (not included) onto the weight tube. If you are using olympic weights, you will need to use the Weight Adapter (20).

For some exercises, you will need to lock the Leg Lever (21) in place. See the inset drawing. To lock the Leg Lever, slide the indicated Foam Pad (11) back from the Leg Lever about one inch. Turn the Leg Lever Lock Pin (37) so that it clips onto the 14" Pad Tube (12). Slide the Foam Pad back into place.
