This was followed up by a focus on another liberal code word, "sustainability" and another presentation that provided yet another excuse to drone on about a well-known (though one might not think so, given all of the "awareness" campaigns), condition that is, to a significant measure, self-inflicted. The remaining speaker covered well-known issues pertaining to clinical trials, and was interesting primarily as a counter-point to the first speaker. If "hiding inconvenient data" is such a problem in the pharmaceutical world, is this not also of concern with respect to the "climate change."
