Saturday, July 7: Alberta Community Thoroughbred Racing Association (ACTRA) Alberta Bred Stakes. For three-year-olds and up Alberta-bred fillies and mares over six furlongs. Purse is \$7,600 plus horsemen's fees of \$150. There is a claiming price of \$5,000.

Sunday, July 8: Alberta Community Thoroughbred Racing Association (ACTRA) Alberta Bred Stakes. For three-year-olds and up Alberta-bred colts and geldings over six furlongs. Purse is \$7,600 plus horsemen's fees of \$150. There is a claiming price of \$5,000.

Sunday, July 8: Sprint Series Race No. 1. Thoroughbreds three-years-old and up racing over 5 ½ furlongs for a purse of \$7,000 plus \$100 horsemen fees.

Sunday, July 8: Jerry Stojan Memorial Trials. For quarter horses over 300 yards and \$11,500 in purse money up for grabs in the finals on July 22.

Saturday, July 14: Marathon Series Race No. 1. Three-year-old thoroughbreds and up over a mile with a purse of \$7,000 plus \$100 horsemen's fees.

Sunday, July 15: Distaff Series Race No. 1. Fillies and mares three-years-old and up racing over 5 ½ furlongs for \$7,000 in purse money plus horsemen's fees of \$100.

Sunday, July 22: Empire Oilfield Solutions Grande Prairie Derby. Three-year-old thoroughbred allowance stake race over a mile with \$13,000 purse plus horsemen's fees of \$150.

Saturday, July 22: Sprint Series Race No. 2. Thoroughbreds three-years-old and up racing over six furlongs for a purse of \$7,000 plus \$100 horsemen fees.

Sunday, July 22: Jerry Stojan Memorial Finals. For quarter horses over 300 yards and \$11,500 in purse money. The trials were held on July 8.

Saturday, July 28: Marathon Series Race No. 2. Three-year-old thoroughbreds and up over 1 1/6 miles with a purse of \$7,000 plus \$100 horsemen's fees.

Sunday, July 29: Peace Country Derby. For three-year-old quarter horses over 400 yards with a purse of \$16,000.

Sunday, July 29: Distaff Series Race No. 2. Fillies and mares three-years-old and up racing over six furlongs for \$7,000 in purse money plus horsemen's fees of \$100.

Sunday, July 29: John MacLeod Memorial. A quarter horse race over 870 yards with a purse of \$8,000.

Sunday, July 29: Grande Prairie Sprint. For quarter horses three-years-old and up over 110 yards with a purse of \$8,000 and horsemen's fees of \$100.

Saturday, August 4: Marathon Series Race No. 3. Three-year-old thoroughbreds and up over 1 1/8 miles with a purse of \$7,000 plus \$100 horsemen's fees. Claiming price is \$7,500.

Saturday, August 4: American Quarter Horse Racing Challenge Series John Deere Juvenile Challenge Trials. Quarter horses racing over 350 yards looking to get into the final August 19 for a purse of \$18,500.
