The Baptism of the Lord



The mystery of Christ's baptism in the Jordan by St John, the Precursor, proposes the contemplation of an already adult Jesus. This mystery is infinitely linked to the Solemnities of the Lord's birth and the Epiphany that we have just celebrated, as in some ways it takes up and represents their significance to us. At Christmas we have contemplated the human birth of the Word incarnate by the Virgin Mary. In the 4th century, the Fathers of the Church deepened the understanding of the faith with regard to the Christmas mystery in the light of Jesus' Humanity. They spoke of the Incarnation of the Word already working like the 'Christification' of that humanity that he had assumed from His mother. Or put in simpler terms: Jesus is the Christ from the first [instant](#) of conception in Mary's spotless womb because He Himself, with His Divine Power, consecrated, anointed and 'Christified' that human nature with which He became incarnate. In the mystery of the Epiphany, we then meditated on Christ's manifestation to all nations that was represented by the Magi, the wise men from the East, who came to adore the Child. Now, in the mystery of Christ's Baptism in the Jordan River, we again encounter and represent the truth of the Lord's incarnation and His manifestation as the Christ. Jesus' Baptism is in fact His definitive manifestation as the Messiah or Christ to Israel, and as the Son of the Father to the entire world. Here we find the dimension of the Epiphany which was His manifestation to all nations. The Father's voice from heaven shows that Jesus of Nazareth is the eternal Son and the descent of the Holy Spirit in the form of a dove shows the Trinitarian nature of the Christian God. The true and unique God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, shows Himself in Christ, through Him, with Him and in Him.

The Baptism in the Jordan returns to the great Christmas theme of 'Christification,' Jesus of Nazareth's spiritual anointing, His presentation as the Anointed One par excellence, the Messiah or the One sent by the Father for the salvation of mankind. The Spirit that descended on Jesus shows and seals in an incontrovertible way the 'Christification' of Jesus' humanity that the Word had already fulfilled from the first moment of His miraculous conception by Mary. Jesus, from the very beginning, was always the Lord's Christ, He was always God. Yet, His one, true humanity, that which is perfect in every way, as the Gospel records, constantly grew in natural and supernatural perfection. '*And Jesus increased in wisdom, in stature, and in favour with God and with men*' (Lk2:52). In Israel at 30 years of age, one reached full maturity and therefore could become a [master](#). Jesus came of age and the Spirit, descending and remaining on Him, definitively consecrated His whole being as the Christ.

The same Spirit, that descended on the water of the River Jordan wafted over the waters during the first creation (Gen 1:2). Therefore, the Baptism in the Jordan presents yet another truth: that Jesus has started a new creation. He is the second man (1 Cor 15:47) or the last Adam (1 Cor 15:45), that comes to repair the first Adam's guilt. He does this as the Lamb of God that takes away our sins.

St. Anthony, Abbot

The life of Anthony will remind many people of Saint Francis of Assisi. At 20, Anthony was so moved by the Gospel message, “Go, sell what you have, and give to [the] poor” (Mark 10:21b), that he actually did just that with his large inheritance. He is different from Francis in that most of Anthony’s life was spent in solitude. He saw the world completely covered with snares, and gave the Church and the world the witness of solitary asceticism, great personal mortification and prayer. But no saint is antisocial, and Anthony drew many people to himself for spiritual healing and guidance.

At 54, he responded to many requests and founded a sort of monastery of scattered cells. Again, like Francis, he had great fear of “stately buildings and well-laden tables.”

At 60, he hoped to be a martyr in the renewed Roman persecution of 311, fearlessly exposing himself to danger while giving moral and material support to those in prison. At 88, he was fighting the Arian heresy, that massive trauma from which it took the Church centuries to recover. “The mule kicking over the altar” denied the divinity of Christ.

Anthony is associated in art with a T-shaped cross, a pig and a book. The pig and the cross are symbols of his valiant warfare with the devil—the cross his constant means of power over evil spirits, the pig a symbol of the devil himself. The book recalls his preference for “the book of nature” over the printed word. Anthony died in solitude at age 105.

“You know the word that he sent to the Israelites, as he proclaimed peace through Jesus Christ, who is the Lord of all, what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.”

The sights and sounds at the Jordan river are so familiar. The conversation of Jesus with His cousin, His desire to show full unity with humankind, the dripping water, the peace dove, the voice from the cloud. But the baptism did not end there. Jesus climbed up the bank and began His ministry.

One day when we were baptized, we began our missionary journey. Baptism for us is not an event, but our own first encounter with Jesus Christ. We were anointed with holy chrism, Christened, with power became dwelling places of the Holy Spirit and we move from the baptismal font to do the same work as Jesus ‘to go about doing good.’ Unfortunately, like a battery that is not used, it loses its power if not used, but like Jesus, God is with us to restore and enable that latent power.

May we renew our lives and our baptismal call.

Fiscal Year Ended August 31, 2019

Dear Parishioners of St. John's:

On behalf of the Finance Council, we share with you the financial highlight report for the fiscal year ended August 31, 2019. The full financial statements of the Parish were recently presented to and approved by the members of the Finance Council and submitted to the Archdiocese Finance Office.

The financial condition of the Parish continues to improve. Under the prudent and diligent management of our Pastor and guided by the Finance Council, the outstanding debt to the Archdiocese has been further reduced. Weekly contributions including WeShare, which fund our normal operating expenses declined approximately 6% from an average of \$17,300 to \$16,300. Participation in WeShare, our electronic giving program increased an average of \$800 per month while in-pew contributions declined an average of \$5,200 per month. We continue to see meaningful reductions in our normal operating expenses to keep pace with reduced operating revenues. In addition to our operating income, we raised \$125,000 as of August 31, 2019 in restricted donations for capital improvements to the Church. These proceeds have been used toward the replacement of the roof, which began in the fall of 2019 and are earmarked for the re-siding of the main Church in 2020.

Our Parish continues to make significant progress toward repaying its outstanding liabilities owed to the Archdiocese. In 2012, the interest-bearing debt was over \$2.5 million, which consisted of loans and outstanding bills from the Parish and the former school. Our debt is now slightly more than \$56,000, excluding our non-interest bearing subvention balance. St. John's has had a very active year. Our Lenten and Thanksgiving Outreaches, Breakfast Run, Food Pantry, Blood Drives, Bible Study Program, St. Patrick's, San Giuseppe, St. Anthony and Padre Pio Masses, Living Rosary, Eagle Scout Projects, May Crowning, Animal Blessing, Mass of the Anointing, Angel Gift Tree and the re-dedication of *Our Lady of Life* garden make for a vibrant and welcoming Parish Community. Parishioners are consistently invited to live their faith here at St. John's.

Finally, the Finance Council would like to thank all those who continued to so generously support your Parish. We would also like to thank Fr. Caruso for his leadership and oversight of the spiritual and financial well-being of the entire St. John's community.
