The month of February is dedicated to the Holy Family

This is also the Year dedicated to St. Joseph.

St. Joseph assumed the greatest mission on earth as head of the Holy Family, a confidence he was to fulfill with unfailing faith. The Gospel account depicts Joseph as a “just man”.

We do not have any words in the Gospel uttered by St. Joseph.

He was strong and silent.

St. Joseph was declared Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX in 1870. He is there for us today.

The unity that was the Holy Family’s continues as a perfect example for the Church today.

Families desperately need an example in our ungodly world today.

It is natural, right and proper that as St. Joseph used to provide for the Holy Family, so now from Heaven he should extend his protection and care to the whole Church of Christ.

Pope Proclaims Year of St. Joseph, Reflection on the Family

Pope Francis proclaimed a Year of St. Joseph for December 8, 2020, through December 8, 2021, to honor the 150th anniversary of the 1870 decree Quemadmodum Deus, which proclaimed St. Joseph to be the patron of the universal Church.

Weeks later, the Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life announced the Holy Father also proclaimed a yearlong time of reflection of family life based on his 2016 post-synodal apostolic exhortation Amoris Laetitia (“The joy of love”). This year begins March 19 and goes until June 26, 2022.

In Patris Corde (“With a father’s heart”), the apostolic letter released at the start of the year of St. Joseph, Pope Francis shared some personal reflections on the spouse of Mary, writing: “Each of us can discover in Joseph – the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence – an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble. St. Joseph reminds us that those who appear hidden or in the shadows can play an incomparable role in the history of salvation. Pope Francis noted that throughout the history of the Church, “After Mary, the Mother of God, no saint is mentioned more frequently in the papal magisterium than Joseph, her spouse.” The Pope noted the roles of his predecessors in helping the faithful recognize St. Joseph’s role in salvation history: Blessed Pius IX declared him “Patron of the Catholic Church”; Venerable Pius XII proposed him as “Patron of Workers”; and St. John Paul II as “Guardian of the Redeemer.” St. Joseph is universally invoked as the “patron of a happy death.”

The Year of St. Joseph, who was head of the Holy Family, goes hand-in-hand with the year “to bear witness to family love.” According to the dicastery’s announcement, the family “deserves a year of celebrations, so that it can be placed at the center of commitment and care from every pastoral and ecclesial reality.”
