## MARYLAND CATHOLIC CONFERENCE

The Maryland Catholic conference encourages Catholics to speak up on dignity of life, education and justice issues during the Maryland General Assembly, which is now in session. SB 169 / HB 372 threatens the religious freedom and conscience rights of Catholic Hospitals and Catholic medical personnel.

If enacted by the Maryland General Assembly, Senate Bill 169 / House Bill 372 on Hospital and Emergency Pregnancy-related Medical Conditions, would undermine constitutional protection of religious freedom and conscience rights of Catholic Hospitals and Catholic medical personnel.

Catholic hospitals already comply with established federal emergency care laws. Ethical and religious directives ensure patients receive care that respects medical necessity and Catholic teachings. The proposed Maryland legislation removes statutory protections for medical providers and faith-based hospitals and imposes severe civil penalties against hospitals and physicians who refuse to perform abortions.

The Senate version has already been approved. The Maryland Catholic Conference and Maryland Right To Life organizations urge action to oppose the legislation now!
