Some specifics for the parish financials are noted below:

Income: The parish received a bequest this fiscal year of a house in the Parish. We sold the house and booked the anticipated archdiocesan assessment on these funds, resulting in a net of \$320,072.

Capital Projects and Major Repairs:

- Replacement of one AC unit in the Gym
- Installation of Key Card System on campus
- Painting of Interior Gym and Purchase of new chairs for the gym
- Renovate backyard, install generator, and add back patio to rectory
- Down payment on new organ for the Church
- Down payment on Projector for Church

School Report: It was a very busy year for the school. Under the leadership of Mrs. Bennett, the school finished the 2021-2022 fiscal year with over 380 students and an operating surplus of \$56,000. The school continued to assist families financially impacted by the pandemic through the St. Angela's Angel's Tuition Assistance Program and through the generosity of parish and school families, the school was able to assist all families who applied for assistance. The school also raised over \$60,000 through their annual Boosterthon to cover the cost of the new gym floor.

Looking Forward to Next year: Thank you for your continued generosity. Please continue your strong support of our parish and school. We plan to continue proper maintenance and improvements to our parish properties and have already started the installation of a projector in the church, gym renovation, and installation of energy efficient lighting throughout the campus. Additionally, we are beginning renovation of the choir area in anticipation of the installation of our new organ and will soon add and replace iron fencing to address security needs on our campus. We have much to look forward to in the year ahead!

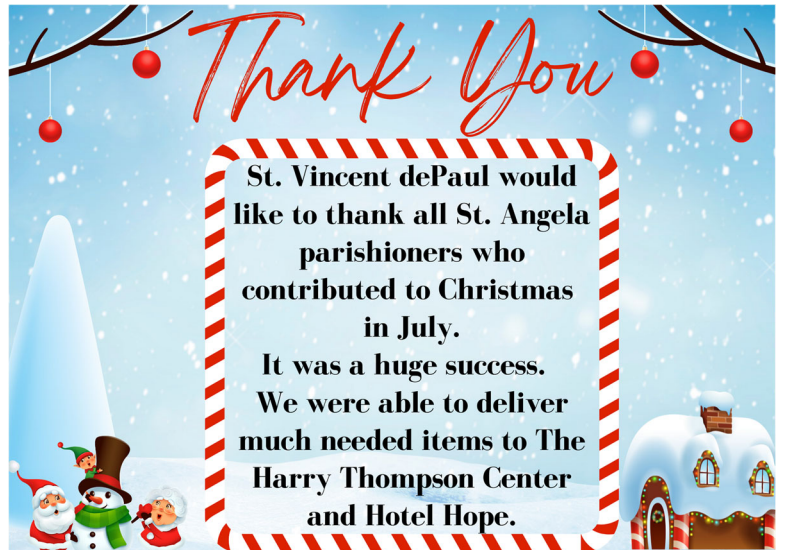

Family Faith Formation

Registration is now open for our 2022-2023 Faith Formation Program. This program meets the faith formation requirement for parish children in grade K-7 who are not currently enrolled in a Catholic school.

It consists of monthly in-person gatherings, typically taking place on the first Monday of every month September-May. These sessions are for BOTH parents and their children and will last approximately from 6:30-8:00 p.m. During this time students will be divided into age-appropriate classes where they will be given a lesson by a volunteer catechist. At the same time, parents will form a separate group where they will be catechized, encouraged, and equipped so as to be able to successfully instruct their children in the faith at home for the remainder of that month. Additionally, each family will be assigned a mentor catechist who will serve as both a resource and support.

During the remaining weeks, families will complete weekly lessons together at home. These lessons are intended to be interactive, filled with games, Scripture quotes, crafts, lives of the saints, etc., and are designed to reinforce and deepen your family's understanding and appreciation of our Catholic faith. Families also are given options, allowing them to choose the lessons/activities which best fit the needs of their particular children.

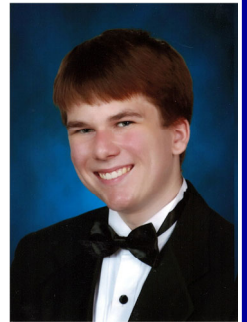
