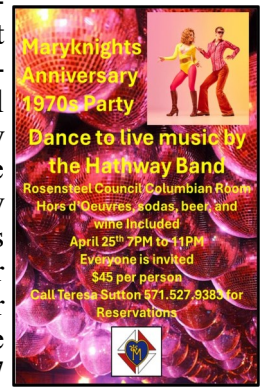
Parental, Spousal and Significant-Other Bereavement Support Group

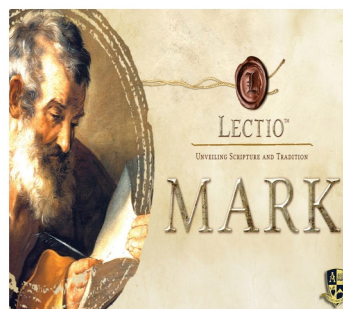


April 25, Natural Family Planning Class for Engaged or Married Couples
