We hope to have the project completed sometime this summer with plenty of good weather left for everyone to have a chance to visit and pray.

EUCHARISTIC MIRACLE EXHIBIT





Meditation Garden Spring Brick Drive



Our Meditation Garden is a beautiful and peaceful space just outside Seton Hall on the East side of the building. It is a lovely place to pray, meditate in silence, talk with a friend, or just sit and enjoy the beauty of God's creation.

Parishioners have the opportunity to purchase engraved bricks as permanent memorials of loved ones, parish families, or special events in the lives of our parishioners.

The bricks can be a remembrance of a variety of family or parish celebrations or events, such as the birth or adoption of a child, a marriage, Confirmation, First Holy Communion, graduation, wedding anniversary, memorial to a loved one, in thanksgiving to a patron saint, a veteran's service, or to show appreciation to a favorite Religious Education teacher or clergy member.



In order to have your child baptized at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the following is

- To be a registered member of our parish.
- Attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Call the Parish Office to register for this class. For your convenience, you may attend the class before your child is born.
- Schedule the Baptism. Baptisms take place on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month following the 11:15AM Mass (12:30PM Baptismal Service).

Sacrament of Marriage

One or both of the engaged couple should be a registered member of the parish. Wedding arrangements need to be made at least six months in advance. Please call the Parish Office to begin the process.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick
