# **PASTOR'S NOTES**

### Mother's Day Thoughts from a Father and Erma.

I have shared this in past years, but good wisdom is always worth repeating. I think Erma has some great insights on the understanding that love is not always a walk in the park. In the Book of Acts St. Paul tells us, "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." In essence, that is what Erma is saying in her message to her children.

Entering the Kingdom of God is entering into His love. God's love is not founded in self-serving interest, but in mature caring and self-sacrificing for the good of others. This is the kind of love a mother and father are called to. It is the kind of love parents try instill in the hearts of their children. Giving our children an easy life is not necessarily helping them to grow up strong, healthy, and wise. Bringing them to Church, despite their protests, is in fact building on a true foundation for their salvation.

### A Mother's Love by Erma Bombeck

Some day when my children are old enough to understand the logic that motivates a mother, I will tell them:

I loved you enough to ask about where you were going, with whom and what time you would get home.

**I loved you enough** to insist that you buy a bike, that we could afford to give you, with your own money.

I loved you enough to make you return a Milky-Way— with a bite out of it—to the drug store and to confess "I stole this."

I loved you enough to stand over you for two hours while you cleaned your room, a job that would have taken me 15 minutes. I loved you enough to let you see anger, disappointment, disgust and tears in my eyes.

I loved you enough to admit I was wrong and ask for your forgiveness.

**I loved you enough** to let you stumble, fall and hurt. **But most of all** I loved you enough to say NO when you ha

**But most of all,** I loved you enough to say NO when you hated me for it. That was the hardest part of all.

To all our Mothers on this special day, may the Lord bless you with peace and joy in all your labors of love. May our Blessed Mother, Mary, enfold you in the mantle of her love and watch over you and your family.

# LITURGY FOR LUNCH: A MOVEABLE FEAST

"What day is Ascension Thursday?" is one of those charming and genuine questions, as quirky and wonderful as so many other things in our Catholic subculture (like "what time is Midnight Mass?").

The short answer: In the Diocese of Fargo, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord is celebrated on and in place of the 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter. This year, that date is May 16.

The longer answer: After Jesus' Resurrection, He spent 40 days walking the Earth, appearing to the faithful women, the apostles, and many others. On the 40<sup>th</sup> day, He ascended into Heaven to take His seat at the right hand of the Father, and promised His disciples that He would send them the Holy Spirit. Nine days later, the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles at Pentecost.

The Liturgical calendar reflects this: 40 days after Easter Sunday (which falls on a Thursday) is the Solemnity of the Ascension, then after 9 days of waiting (a Novena), Pentecost is celebrated 50 Days after Easter (which always falls on a Sunday).

Since the late 1990's, local bishops in the US have had the authority to transfer the Solemnity of the Ascension to the following Sunday, and so replace the celebration of the 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter with the Ascension. Most dioceses in the US (the exceptions being the northeastern seaboard and Nebraska) exercise this option. Other countries like Canada, Mexico, and parts of Europe do the same. While there are pros and cons to transferring the Ascension to Sunday, the choice is the decision of the local bishop.

Therefore, for the faithful in the Diocese of Fargo, the Thursday that falls 40 days after Easter is celebrated as "Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter," and the Solemnity of the Ascension is transferred to the following Sunday.
