Even before I became a Minnesotan, I felt that saying goodbye was always hard. When you become interested or attached to someone, it can be difficult to call it a day, to press pause, or to accept the fact that it's time to head out to somewhere new.

As I conclude my ministry at Pax Christi, I want to offer a special word of thanks to Father Bill. From the beginning of my assignment he has been preparing me to become a pastor someday. He has shared his decades of wisdom and experience with me, and I am grateful to God

for it. I'm also thankful for Father Bill's capacity to plumb the depths of human life's griefs and sorrows with others, and, at the end of a long day, he can still make you laugh with a joke and by not taking himself too seriously. I will take these many lessons with me for a long time to come.

My gratitude overflows as well to all of you, the people of God at Pax Christi, for so many memories of grace. At the Eucharist, my heart swelled to hear you sing to the Lord with faith and passion. In our classrooms, I saw the Catholic faith being passed on to our youth through the scriptures and through acts of love. During parish leadership nights, I was inspired by the harmony of diverse gifts of the Spirit that you offer to serve this community in all its richness—clergy and lay, women and men, young and old, and of many cultures. At our office, our creative and dedicated staff energized me to develop myself and learn from their wisdom. I have been truly blessed by you and your discipleship of Jesus Christ. I am grateful.

As I depart and as we welcome Father Mike Byron as pastor, my heart turns toward the altar. There, around the table of the Lord, we are never truly separated. Wherever even just a few are gathered in the name of Jesus, there too is the whole Church. We as a Church are the mystical body of Christ, stretching across nations, lands, people, languages, and even across time. My pledge is to hold you all in my heart whenever I celebrate the festival of salvation that we call the Holy Mass.

It's been a great two years together. Please do pray for me to be a wise and gentle shepherd. Remember me at the altar. And, next time you are near the parishes of Roseville, know that *all are welcome*.
