FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Hello parish family,

I hope that everyone is doing well and enjoying these summer months-- in particular as we find ourselves enjoying a greater ability to do more outside activities under the Phase 4 directives and guidelines from the state.

With these summer months and the growing response of people venturing out into public again, we have been noticing that more and more people are beginning to come back to Mass ... which is so awesome! Praise God!

As a parish, we continue to rejoice in our ability to minister to you all with the celebration of holy Mass and the Sacraments, but also the restoration of group meetings in our parish facilities-- all with the blessing of the Bishop and in accord with the diocesan directives.

In order for us to continue to do so, we ask for your continued cooperation regarding the wearing of masks at all times, the use of hand sanitizer upon entering the church, maintaining social distancing at all times, etc.

One area we are watching is reaching the 30% capacity Diocesan guideline (which is approximately 204 people— depending on how people are grouped in pews allowing for social distancing). Because we have been fortunate to allow walk-ins attend Mass, we have been noticing a growing interest in people coming to our 11:15AM Mass-- to the point where we are very close to the capacity limit.


As a friendly reminder, if we reach our 30% capacity, we will have to lock the church doors so we do not exceed that number. This is in the interest of public health and safety as well as compliance with state and Diocesan guidelines.

And so, I would *highly recommend* that registered parishioners consider arriving earlier for Mass or maybe even consider attending one of the other three weekend Masses (which have a lower attendance that isn't currently close to 30% capacity. No one wants to be turned away for Mass, so please make an adjustment if you are one who typically arrives right at Mass time.

I thank you in advance for your continued support of our parish and for your beautiful faith. Thank you for your patience and your love for the Lord. Know of my continued prayers for all of you. God bless!




Men's Night Out

It has been a number of months since I have put anything in the bulletin and so I thought it was time to bring you all up to speed. Last fall I jumped into my new role as Director of Evangelization and began rolling out some fresh ideas and programs. Obviously it all came to a screeching halt in March as the pandemic hit. My role greatly changed as I adapted to what Fr. Grady needed of me. I learned new technology (ZOOM & Live Streaming to name a couple) and helped him find creative ways to reach out to all of you. Often that included standing in the rain collecting Sunday envelopes or selling Word Among us while the priests did a Eucharistic blessing. Each week as new directives from the state and bishop came out, we would scramble to meet the requirements so that we could efficiently move forward in a timely fashion with re-opening. It has been challenging, interesting and yet very rewarding (to say the least!) trying to meet the needs of the people, which are many and varied!

But now, God willing we are getting back on track! I want to share with you some dates as to when we will be re-starting some of our programs:

Our awesome new **RE program** called **FIRE** is starting this fall. This is an **AMAZING** program for families who have kids in K-7th grade. It meets only once a month-- respecting the busy lives of families these days. We have great teachers lined up and innovative ways to teach the faith to your children! The early bird discount ends August 5th, so register in the parish office today!

We will have our next **Tear Drops Prayer Service on August 17 at 6:30PM**. If you have family or friends who have fallen away or who are not practicing the faith, this is the time to come and pray for them! Bring them to the Lord in your heart and beg for their return and conversion during this beautiful 30-minute service filled with prayer, song, and scripture. Prayer is powerful!

We will start our **Sisters of Grace Prayer Group and Book Study** for women again on **October 5th at 6:30PM**. We will meet on the first Monday of each month. The new book we will be doing is called **Saintly Women for Modern Times - by Joan Caroll Cruz**. You may pick up a copy in the parish office for \$15. Please email me or call the office to sign up for this group as we do have limits as to how many can attend. We have 30 copies of the book.

Parish Mission - October 25-27. Fr. Caliente, a priest of the Diocese of Rockford who was a monk but got a call within a call to come out into the world to be a diocesan priest, will give our parish mission! He will share his fascinating vocation story and

help each of us realize our potential including how to go deeper in prayer. Fr. Caliente is one of those priests that you hang on every word he says. Mark your calendars!

I am excited to announce that our **Ministry Fair** will happen again this year. Hold the dates of **November 14 & 15**. After all Masses, each parish ministry will have the opportunity to have a table set up in the parish hall with flyers/brochures and a member there to answer questions people might have. I will be updating the ministry booklets we used last year. Ministry leaders- watch your email in August as I send that out for you to make corrections or changes. Fr. Grady will preach all Masses that weekend to help get our parishioners excited about signing up for a new ministry!

Seniors Group - At this time we are still keeping this one on hold for obvious reasons, but I really do hope to get that up and rolling in early 2021. Watch the bulletin for dates.

There are a few more things that will be coming your way - but that is all I will talk about for now. My prayer is that in the 5 months that are left of 2020, we may all find new ways to stir up the fire of the Holy Spirit that is within us. For as one of my favorite saints, St. Jane Frances de Chantal says, "The devil fears hearts on fire with love of God."






**Think you know the Knights of Columbus?



Requirements for Baptism

In order to have your child baptized at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the following is required:

- To be a registered member of our parish.
- Attend a Baptismal Preparation class (call the Parish Office to register for this class in advance as space is limited). For your convenience, you may attend the class before your child is born.
- Schedule the Baptism- the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month following the 11:15AM Mass (12:30PM Baptismal Service).
