From Amanda's Desk,

"You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you; and the things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?' Thus will it be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God."

I was sitting with my brother in-law at the Fisher Cats game this past Saturday (thank you to all our families who came to enjoy a fun night out!) and a sign came across the billboard that said "Financial Literacy." I turned to him and said, "eww, I don't wanna think about that while I'm eating my dip n' dots." He said, "Well, people have no clue! They're all like, 'Wait, my money can MAKE me money?"" - to which I said "....Wait, my money CAN make me money?" We laughed and I mentally noted that I need to brush up on my financial literacy... right after I finished those dip n' dots.

If this Gospel passage had a billboard, it would read, "Invest in your spiritual 401K!"

Today, we are totally CONSUMED by "the right now" - which, ultimately, is always temporary. Whether it's mindlessly scrolling through 30 second videos, or finding a way to power through this "thing" when our tank is (literally or figuratively) on E, there doesn't seem to be much room for anything anymore, other than "right now."

Focusing on our Faith or spiritual pursuits can sometimes feel like a luxury afforded for when we have the time <u>vs</u> an ESSENTIAL element of what makes us whole.

Moreover, taking time for ourselves IN GENERAL doesn't feel like a luxury that a lot of us can afford in the lifestyle our society has demanded of us. For us "younger folk," (if 35 still counts in that category...) sometimes it feels like TO SURVIVE is to BE CONSUMED, lest we "take a break" and fall irreparably behind in the social, financial, lifestyle or personal pursuits we've worked so hard for. ... when in reality, that's exactly what we need to do to make space for each other and for our God.

Did we make time for God in the craziness of our "right now?" Because, when the ULTIMATE "right now" that begins as we transition from this life to the next - will Jesus know us through the relationship we're built with Him?

I don't have all the answers, but here's what I've got (so far) - Don't wait until everything is checked off on "the list" to make time for yourself, or (more importantly) to make time for God. There's no "wrong time" to pray, and there's no "wrong way" to start a conversation / have a relationship with Him. So make time, whatever you've got, to invest regularly in Him!

In closing, when the ULTIMATE "right now" comes, it won't be about the things, promotions, days you had perfect attendance, sleep you lost, how far you got on "the list" - Ultimately, it will be about how you loved, served and lived for others - so don't let today's clutter get in the way of the ultimate tomorrow. Invest in your relationship with God.
