The word of God teaches us to pursue righteousness rather than selfishness. When we ourselves suffer, as Jesus did for us, we grow in humility and empathy toward others. We learn to re-evaluate our priorities and place love for God and our neighbor above pleasure, power, and wealth. Though not a good in itself, suffering can change our hearts, move us to repentance, and return us to God.

#### LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, God issues a warning through Amos to complacent and self-serving Israelites. In the second reading, Paul charges Timothy to live up to his call as a man of God *until the appearance of our Lord Jesus Christ*. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the rich man and Lazarus. The rich man received what was good during his lifetime while ignoring Lazarus' suffering. In death, their situations are reversed.


#### **2025 SEMINARIAN APPEAL**



In the previous week's articles, we have looked at the importance of singing as







## LECTIO DIVINA, EXPLAINED!

Lectio divina ("divine reading") is a practice of praying through the reading of Scripture, opening oneself to the inspiration and communication of the Holy Spirit.

The practice of *Lectio divina* dates to ancient monastic communities, but it has gained popularity in modern times as a way to meaningfully engage with the word of God.

The formula for *Lectio divina* is simple and follows four steps. The text of the Scripture is read *(lectio)* multiple times, and the reader takes note of any words or phrases that resonate with him in a particular way. The reader then reflects deeply on the passage *(meditatio)* and the words that he noticed, turning them over in his mind. Following this, the reader prays with the passage *(oratio)*, and dialogues with God, inviting him to illuminate the reader's understanding of the text. Finally, there is rest and

contemplation (contemplatio).
