Deacon Del will deliver the socks to those in need at the Minneapolis Opportunity Center where he serves the homeless on a weekly basis. Literature will be available on Feed My Starving Children, as well as information on opportunities to assist with serving meals at St. Stephen's Parish in Minneapolis.
