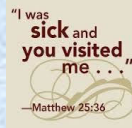

SACRAMENTAL CARE

Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism for infants and children under the age of seven is celebrated the 2nd Saturday of each month. Parents are to attend a 2 session preparation class which is held on the 2nd and 3rd Monday of each month. Parents must attend both sessions before baptism of their child. It is recommended that the class be attended before the birth of the child. This will ensure minimal wait before their baby is baptized.

Sponsors are welcome but are not required to attend the class. Please call the office to register.

Children who have attained seven years of age are to be involved in their preparation for the sacraments. Contact the office for more information.

Anointing of the Sick: Any parishioner who is scheduled for serious surgery should receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to the hospitalization. Please contact the office to arrange for a time to celebrate the sacrament.

Parishioners in danger of death due to sickness or old age should be anointed and receive viaticum. Please contact the parish office or after-hours emergency number for the ministry of a priest.

Marriage: Couples desiring to marry in the church, please email marriageprep@saintfaustinachurch.org at least six to nine months ahead of anticipated wedding date. **Week day, evening and Saturday appointments** are available.

Low Gluten Hosts are available to those in need. Please see one of the Deacons or Acolytes before the Mass you are attending so we are able to accommodate you.


Even though our programs are currently all virtual, we are still in need of help in different areas, especially with the following:

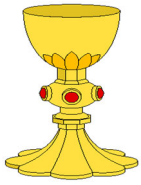

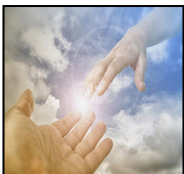

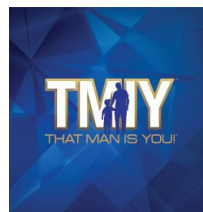
