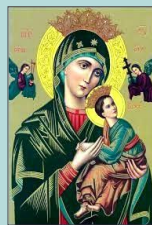

THE MISSIONARY IMAGE OF
OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE
OCTOBER 12-19

We are hosting one of the Missionary Images here at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, now until Monday, October 19th.

The Missionary Images of Our Lady of Guadalupe are the only four images in the world commissioned by the Basilica Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City to journey as Missionary Images on a Mission in the New Evangelization to bring conversions and a Culture of Life and Civilization of Love, for which St. John Paul II prayed. St. John Paul II also named Our Lady of Guadalupe as the ‘Star of The New Evangelization’.



These images are rare, special and extraordinary! Because of Our Lady of Guadalupe’s special mission, they have traveled the world bringing many signs, wonders, conversions, healings and graces. The images have manifested signs such as detections of the heartbeat of an unborn baby in the womb that was confirmed by doctors and nurses with stethoscopes, the shedding of tears of oil and holy glitter. God manifests these signs at His pleasure and delights to give them to help strengthen our faith and our confidence in the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

These are not just images. They represent the spiritual presence of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The presence that is brought with the Missionary Image will be present at St. EAS.

The mission of the Missionary Image apostolate is to bring conversions, reverence for life, sanctity of the family and solidarity of the Church in America with the end of abortion and the culture of death and a new culture of life and civilization of love through the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

We invite everyone to come into the main church where the Missionary Image will be present for one week. This is a wonderful opportunity to witness up-close the image that was left on St. Juan Diego’s tilma exactly as it was revealed almost 500 years ago in Mexico.

For those who may never be able to make a pilgrimage to witness the actual tilma in person, this is the next best thing!

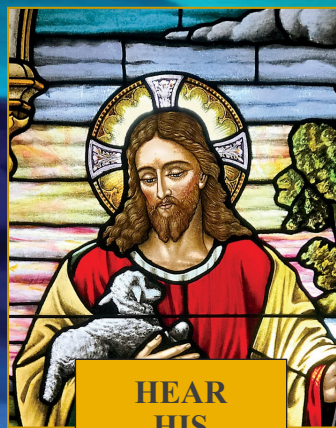

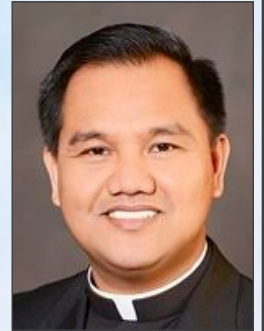

We are very excited to announce our Fall Parish Mission and Retreat will be held **Sunday, October 25 through Tuesday, October 27 at 6:30PM each evening in the main church.**

Fr. Ervin Pio M. Caliente will be presenting our mission. Fr. Caliente is a priest of the Diocese of Rockford and the Pastor of Saint Rita Parish in Rockford. He finished his priestly formation at the University of Saint Mary of the Lake/Mundelein Seminary and was ordained priest in 2015. Fr. Caliente completed the Spiritual Direction Training Program for Priests with the Institute of Priestly Formation and has given retreats to priests, religious contemplative communities and numerous parish retreats. In 2017, he was inspired to begin a spiritual fraternity of priests and an army of lay adorers for the sanctification of priests and the healing of the Church from scandals.

CHANGE IN PROCEDURE

Last week, the Diocese issued revised Covid-19 liturgical directives for the celebration of holy Mass. One of the changes made by the Bishop to the directives is to *allow the*

reception of Holy Communion on the tongue during the celebration of the Mass.

Effective immediately, we will be implementing the following procedure that was given to us by the Diocese in order to alleviate any potential concerns of the faithful and allow for a better flow in receiving Our Lord in the Eucharist. For simplicity and consistency, this is the new procedure for ALL Masses (both weekend and weekday).

Therefore—

The Celebrant (the priest offering the Mass) will ONLY be distributing Holy Communion on the tongue.

The other priest/deacons will ONLY be distributing Holy Communion in the hand.

We ask that you please strictly follow this procedure. Please do not request or insist that the one distributing Holy Communion deviate from this procedure.

If you are seated in a different section and wish to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, you must enter the Celebrant's communion line.

If you are seated in the section where the Celebrant is and you do not wish to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, you will need to go the other priest or the deacon's line to receive.

We thank you for your continued understanding and cooperation as well as your patience and flexibility while we address these challenging times as best we can.

Requirements for Baptism

In order to have your child baptized at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the following is required:

- To be a registered member of our parish.
- Attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. Call the Parish Office to register for this class. For your convenience, you may attend the class *before* your child is born.
- Schedule the Baptism. Baptisms take place on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month following the 11:15AM Mass (12:30PM Baptismal Service).

Sacrament of Marriage

One or both of the engaged couple should be a registered member of the parish. Wedding arrangements need to be made *at least* six months in advance. Please call the Parish Office to begin the process.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick
