Saint John of the Cross

Saint John of the Cross was born Juan de Yepes y Alvarez, in Fontiveros, Avila, Spain in 1542. His father was employed by wealthy family members as an accountant, but they disowned him when he married a poor woman from the lower class. As a result of his family's poverty, John's family suffered greatly. His father died when he was three, and his older brother, Luis died two years after that, likely because of malnutrition.

John's mother eventually found work weaving which helped her to feed her family. As a child, John was sent to a boarding school for poor and orphaned children. He was given a religious education from a young age and chose to follow a religious path, even as a child. He served as an acolyte at an Augustinian monastery. As he grew older, he went to work in a hospital while attending a Jesuit school. In 1563, he was able to join the Carmelite Order and took the name, "John of St. Matthias." He made vows the following year, and was sent to the university in Salamanca to study theology and philosophy. He became an expert [in the Bible](#) and dared to translate the Song of Songs into Spanish, an act which was controversial since the Church forbade the translation of the Bible from Latin -a measure to protect the original meanings in the scripture.

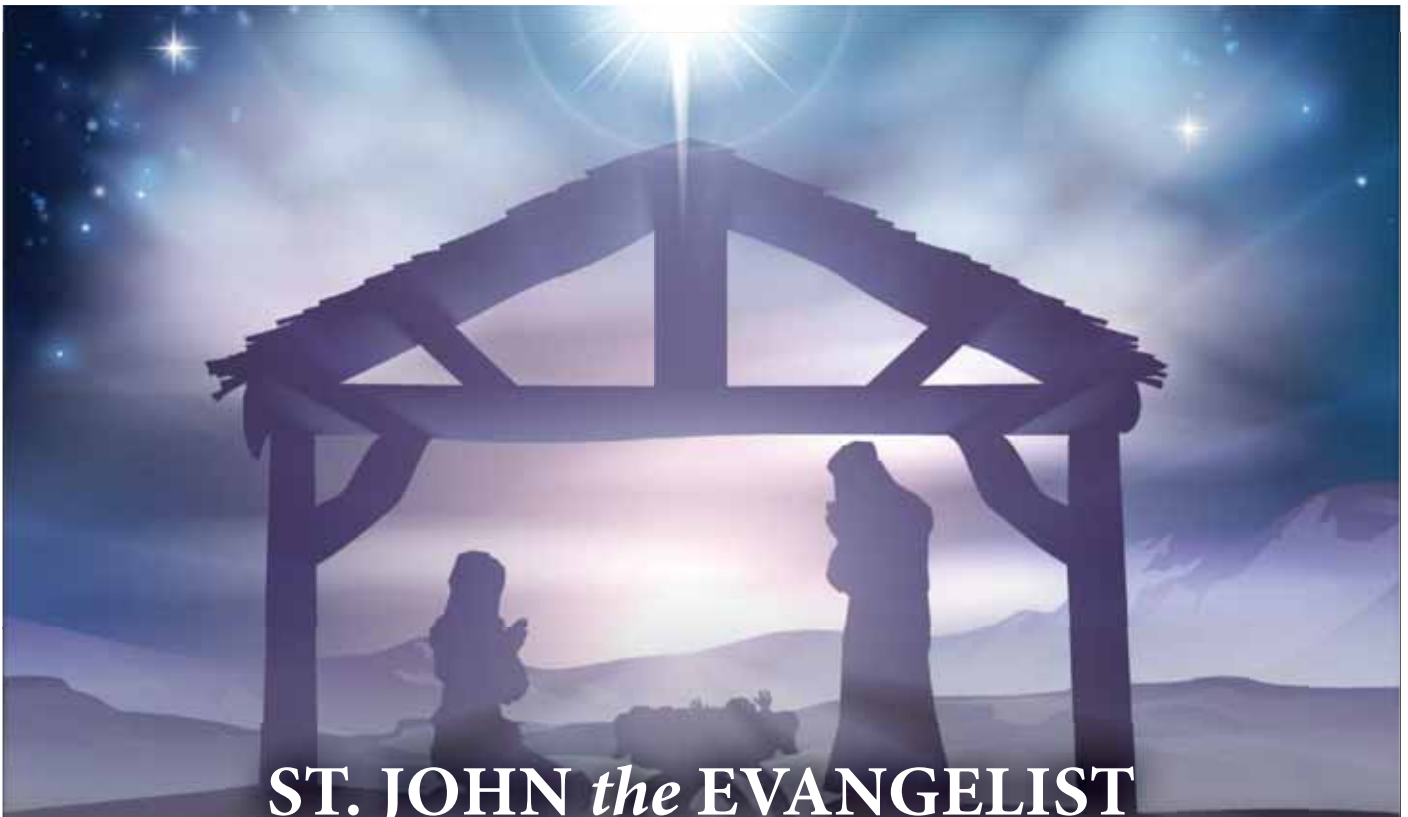

Annual Financial Report
Fiscal Year Ended August 31, 2018

Dear Parishioners of St. John's,

On behalf of the Finance Council, we share with you the financial highlight report for the fiscal year ended August 31, 2018. The full financial statements of the Parish were recently presented to and approved by the members of the Finance Council and submitted to the Archdiocese Finance Office.

The financial condition of the Parish continues to improve. Under the prudent and diligent management of our Pastor and guided by the Finance Council, the outstanding debt to the Archdiocese has been further reduced. Weekly contributions including We Share (Parish Pay), which fund our normal operating expenses declined by approximately 5.1% from an average of \$18,200 to \$17,300. Participation in We Share, our electronic giving program declined slightly, an average of \$100 per month while in pew declined an average of \$3,800 per month. We have made meaningful reductions in our normal operating expenses, including reducing our maintenance administrative overhead; we will continue to seek ways to reduce them going forward. Astute Parish management has resulted in \$10,000 of event rental income, some of which is recurring and we are exploring additional opportunities.

Some of the major improvements and safety projects completed this year included installation of entrance to the school building and competing Phase II of the Prayer Garden.

Our Parish continues to make significant progress toward repaying its outstanding liabilities owed to the Archdiocese. In 2012, the debt was over \$2.5 million, which consisted of loans and outstanding bills from the Parish and the former school. Since last year, the debt has been reduced by \$152,000 in principal payments on interest-accruing debt. Our debt is now slightly more than \$216,000, not including our subvention balance.

We have had a very active year including our Lenten Outreach, Hoops for Hope, Blood Drives (3), St. Patrick's Day, San Giuseppe, St. Anthony and Padre Pio Masses, Easter Food Blessing, Living Rosary, Luminary Mass, Three Eagle Scout Projects, One, Gold Award Project, May Crowning, Parish Feast Day, Animal Blessing, Mass of the Anointing, Thanksgiving Outreach, Abounding Parish Christmas Tree Giving, Broadway Show, Doo Wop Night and our new Adult Outreach that did a spring and fall run into NYC to feed and clothe the homeless. This and much more; come and live your faith.

Finally, the Finance Council would like to thank all those who continue to so generously support your Parish. We would also like to thank Father Phil Caruso for his leadership and oversight of the spiritual and financial well-being of the entire Saint John's community.

Subvention agreements are contingency liabilities subject to repayment only in the event the Parish were to receive a sizable unrestricted donation, bequest or sale of property and the repayment would not compromise or impair the ongoing fiscal operation of the Parish.

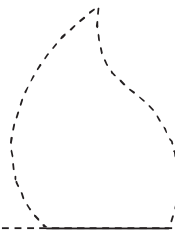

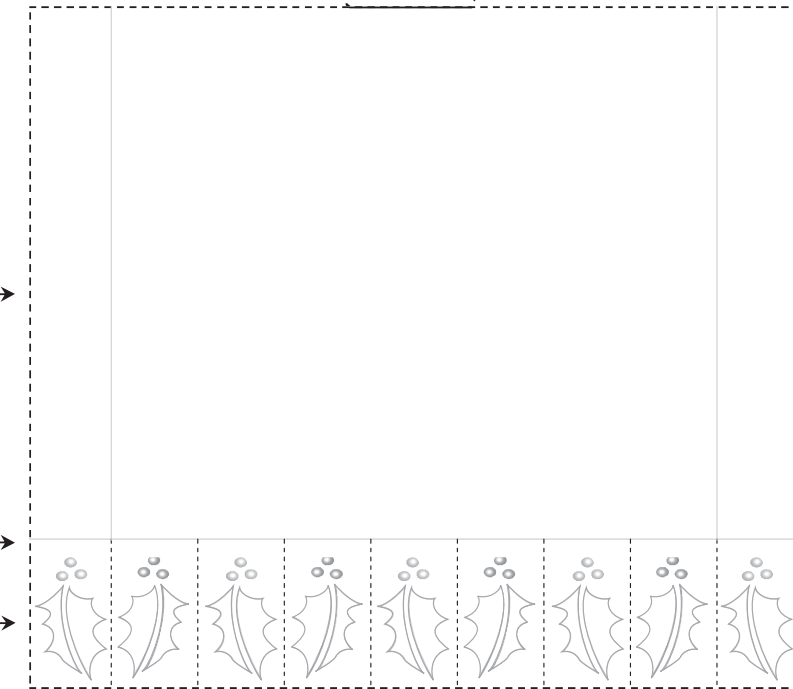

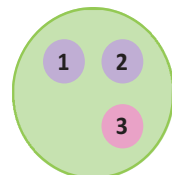
