Dear Parishioners,

Merry Christmas! As we celebrate Christmas 2025, I invite you to reflect with me on the profound promise found in Isaiah 62:4: *“No more shall people call you ‘Forsaken,’ or your land ‘Desolate,’ but you shall be called ‘My Delight.’”*

These prophetic words remind us of God’s original vision for humanity. In the beginning, God created us in His image and declared that we were “very good” (Genesis 1:26-31). However, throughout history - from the Israelites in exile to our own modern experiences of war and hardship - many have felt "forsaken" by circumstance or "desolate" in spirit.

Christmas is God’s ultimate answer to those labels. Through the birth of Jesus, God did not merely send a message; He came in person to claim us. The Hebrew name *Hephzibah* (“My delight is in her”) signifies this radical transformation of identity. In the manger, we see that we are no longer defined by past failures or current trials, but by God’s active love and favor.

Humanity’s self-inflicted wounds of sin lead toward decay, but God refused to watch His creation succumb to annihilation. Instead, He entered into our world to restore us to our original glory. This is the heart of Christmas: the "Light of the World" meeting our desolation to bring a new beginning to every heart that welcomes Him.

How should we respond to such an undeserved gift?

- **With Gratitude:** Acknowledge the wonder of *Emmanuel*, God with us.
- **With Joy:** Join the angels in singing, *“Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men”* (Luke 2:14).
- **By Embracing Your Name:** Remember that you are precious to Him - not because of what you do, but because of who you are in Christ.

As we reach the conclusion of this 2025 Jubilee Year, our "Holy Year of Hope," the Nativity serves as the perfect seal upon our journey. We began this year as "Pilgrims of Hope," and we end it at the manger, seeing that Hope has a face and a name: Jesus. While the Holy Doors across the world will soon close, the door of God’s heart remains forever open. May the graces of this Jubilee year continue to flourish in you, reminding you that no matter what the future holds, you are never forsaken because Christ is our eternal Hope.

In the hustle and bustle of this season, I encourage our Saint Elizabeth Catholic Church/School family and friends to look beyond the glamour to the stillness of the nativity crib. There, Jesus whispers: *"You are My Delight."*

I especially pray that the peace of Christmas lightens the hearts of those mourning loved ones or facing difficult life changes. May you set aside the labels the world has given you and embrace the new name God speaks over you today. May your homes become living cribs, radiating the joy of the Christ Child to a world in need of His love.

I wish you and your families a very blessed Christmas and a prosperous New Year!

**CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE**

This past weekend at each Mass, the parish capital campaign committee provided an update to our progress. As you know, we are needing to raise \$2.1 million to fund many needed improvements across our campus. As you are also aware, we kicked off this Campaign last month, on the Feast of St. Elizabeth.

So how are we doing? One month in, we are pleased to report that we have already received 3-year pledges and one-time gifts totaling over 6% of our goal. While 6% is not bad for one month, we still have a very long way to go!
