Why did God's people need to be saved?


God created the first people to be like him. He made them happy and gave them a garden to care for. Adam and Eve made a bad choice. They brought sin into the world.



Jesus died for all people to save them from their sins. Jesus gave his life so that people could have new life with God.






## **Sharing Good News**


Invite a friend to come to church with you.

Forgive someone who is sorry for hurting you.




