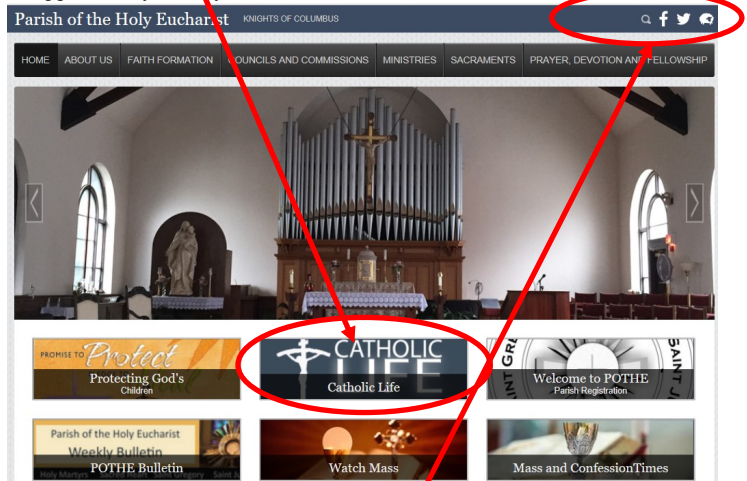


ADORATION MINISTRY BREAKFAST WITH FR. DANIEL

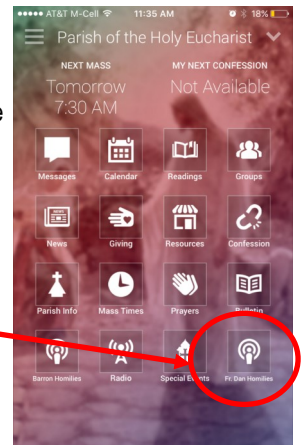
