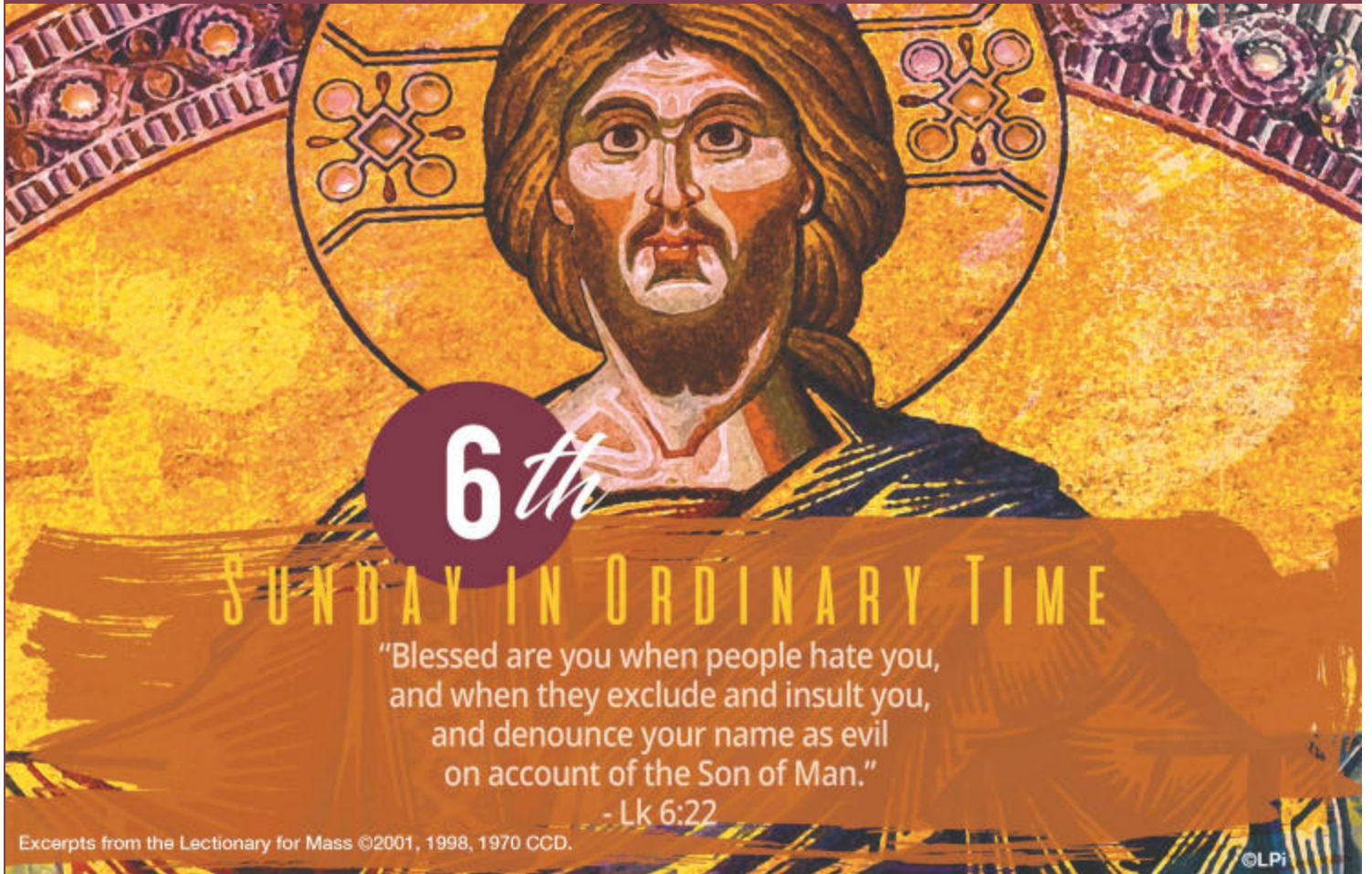

Msgr. Colwell's Musings

In his letter to the Ephesians, St. Paul describes the Christians "walk" of life, the Christian lifestyle. The Christian is to walk in unity and in community with his fellow saints. The Christian is to walk in a way that is dramatically different from the walk of an unbeliever. Christians are further instructed to "walk in love". And most importantly, St. Paul speaks of the Christian's lifestyle as a "walk as children of light" (5:7-14). If we are to walk in a manner that is consistent with our calling, St. Paul instructs us, we are to live as those who are "children of light."

One might be under the impression that faith in Jesus Christ requires no great change, and that one need but to "add" Christ to his experience, to "invite Christ into his life," and then life will become more pleasant, but at little cost to the Christian.

Being a Christian is not so much a matter of adding Christ to our lives as it is abandoning our lives to find true life in Christ. And when we truly trust in the person and work of Jesus Christ, the change is not small. It is a radical transformation. It is a change from death to life, from darkness to light.

Let us allow the light of Christ to have a radical impact on our priorities, our values, our choices, and our conduct. Let us, as Christians, walk in unity and in community. Let us walk in love. And most importantly, let walk as children of light.

1. Rejoice at the gift of new life!

3. Parents and godparents who have completed the Baptism registration form and been active, stewarding members of St. Mary's for at least six months will then be notified by the Parish Office to come to their respective Baptism Sunday Orientation.
4. Parish staff will direct parents and godparents how to access and participate in online preparation through formed.org as well the next steps in readying themselves for such a splendid responsibility.
5. Baptisms involving families who have already been through preparation will then occur at our weekend Masses *every first weekend of the month* -- **Baptism Sunday**
•Our goal is that parents and godparents engage in preparation while the parents are still expecting which will result in a smoother run up to the day of grace when their child is baptized.



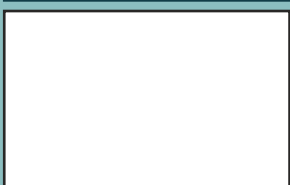
