# St. Ignatius After School Enrichment Program 2020

#### **Dear Students and Parents:**

Welcome to the St. Ignatius After School Enrichment Program! The courses outlined in this booklet are open to all currently enrolled St. Ignatius students in grades 1-8. The focus of this program is to provide exciting educational opportunities and expand the student's knowledge of the world around them.

<u>Class Dates:</u> The classes will be held on three consecutive <u>Tuesdays: January 7th, January 14th, and January 21th from 3:45 p.m.</u> If school is canceled for the day due to bad weather or any unforeseen emergency, the Enrichment Program will also be canceled. We have one make-up day planned for January 28th if necessary. There are no refunds.

The cost is \$30 per child. AFTER COMPLETING THE REGISTRATION ONLINE YOU MUST SEND A CHECK TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE MADE PAYABLE TO "ST. IGNATIUS PTO." You may write one check per family (\$30 x number of children registered). In the memo please include all of the students' names that your have registered. THE CHECK SHOULD BE IN AN ENVELOPE MARKED ASE. REGISTRATION, INCLUDING PAYMENT, IS DUE BY FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 15TH TO SECURE A SPOT.

<u>Confirmation</u>: Every effort is made to grant students their first class choice. If a class has enrollment greater than they can accommodate, selection will be done on a random basis but last year's class list will be taken into consideration. Class confirmation will be sent via email starting December 5th. If your first choice class has been filled, you will receive a notice of the confirmation of your second or third choice. If you do not receive confirmation of one of your class choices, you will be sent a selection of the class openings that are left. All students will receive final confirmation by December 15th.

Before/After Class: When the regular school day ends, students will be sent to their Enrichment classroom. Parents are required to come to their child's designated Enrichment classroom promptly at 4:45 p.m. to pick up students.

IF YOUR CHILD CANNOT ATTEND ENRICHMENT CLASS, BUT IS PRESENT IN SCHOOL ON THAT DAY, WE ASK THAT YOU CALL THE SCHOOL OFFICE AT 389-3242 TO LET THEM KNOW THEY WILL NOT BE ATTENDING OR CONTACT ONE OF THE COORDINATORS.


## **CRYSTAL CLEAR SCIENCE**
