

ONE THOUSAND THANK YOUS

Last February, while recovering from influenza I started researching kindness. I found many ideas, one of which was to give One Thousand Thank Yous. That idea resonated with me, it stuck. Things roll around in my brain a lot before there is a way for something to come to fruition.

March 13, 2020 was our last day of in-person learning due to the pandemic. Like many of you I was worried, scared, and uncertain of what was happening in my home, my school, my neighborhood, my state, my country and my world. The alternative to the worry for me was to focus on the good that was happening. I saw multiple reports of healthcare workers and the steps they were taking to care for others; shifts without end, keeping their families safe by sleeping in their garages, and worrying least about themselves in our time of crisis. I was in awe of the human spirit and so happy to see good still exists.

As the Home and School Association chair of the Catholic Schools Week Committee at our school I had the opportunity to make the One Thousand Thank You idea a reality. We have approximately 500 students who are each creating eight thank you notes to healthcare workers during Catholic Schools Week, January 31 to February 5, 2021. The 4,000 thank you notes will be delivered to Lutheran Hospital for distribution to their 3,900 employees.

It is important for us as a school to recognize the dedication of all those in healthcare; housekeeping, chaplains, registration, techs, nurses, doctors, administrators and all the others who keep the hospital running so it is ready if and when we need their help. These people are our neighbors and friends. We celebrate and appreciate all of those in healthcare who are working tirelessly to care for us and bring us to health. Thank you.
