

DIOCESAN GUIDANCE

The latest Diocesan guidance leaves three remaining COVID 19 restrictions in place:

- 1. We are to forgo the procession
- 2. We are to forgo the sign of peace
- 3. We are to forgo the distribution of the Precious Blood

The dispensations from the requirement to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is rescinded effective June 19-20. The offertory basket will remain at the entrances of the churches, for now. We no longer need to clean the pews and the last recorded Mass and Communion outside of Mass was June 13th. This weekend, Father's homily will be recorded, but not the whole mass.
