

Jesus told the Apostles to eat his body and blood. This was the beginning of the Catholic Mass.





Paschal Candle


Each year, a new candle is lit during the Easter Vigil Mass. It is called the paschal candle. This candle will be lit for every Mass during the Easter season.

Easter season lasts for 50 days.

What is on a Paschal Candle?

| Cross | † | Jesus died on the cross |
|------------------------|-----|--|
| Five grains of incense | | A symbol of the 5 wounds of Jesus—in his hands, his feet, and his side |
| Five nails | | Nails in Jesus' hands and feet and the spear in his side |
| Ålpha & Omega | ΑΩ | Greek letters for the beginning and the end. Another name for Jesus |
| Chi Rho | R | The first 2 letters of Christ in Greek |
| Lamb | X | Jesus is the Lamb of God |
| IHS | ihs | The first 3 letters of Jesus in Greek |
| Butterfly | \$ | A symbol of resurrection |
| Bread & Wine | | A symbol of the Eucharist |



The readings today tell the story of God's great works from Creation to Jesus' resurrection.




Mary of Magdala went to visit the tomb where Jesus was buried and saw that the stone was rolled away. Jesus rose from the dead.





Saint George was a brave soldier in the Roman army. The Emperor, Diocletian, hated Christians! Saint George stood up to him and told Diocletian that he was wrong.







The stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone.


