What is Accepted:

- Clothing (infant to senior)
- Accessories pocketbooks, shoes, boots, belts

FUNDRAISER HELPS OUR YOUTH MINISTRY PROGRAM

What is Accepted:

- Bottles and Cans that are clearly marked as eligible for Return Deposit in MA (such as many brands of beer, wine coolers, and soda)
- All donations must be rinsed and bagged; sorting by material (can, plastic, glass) is also very helpful.

What is NOT Accepted:

- Bottles and Cans that are NOT eligible for Return Deposit in MA (such as hard cider, coffee drinks, juice, lemonade, iced tea, milk drinks, sports drinks, and water). Please check each item to be sure it is marked for Return Deposit for MA. If the label has been damaged or removed, we can not accept it.
- Dirty or sticky bottles and cans. Anything you bring will need to be checked and handled by our student volunteers. Please be considerate of them and everyone else who will need to handle your donated bottles and cans.
