Dear Students and Parents:

Welcome to the St. Ignatius After School Enrichment Program! The courses outlined are open to all currently enrolled St. Ignatius students in grades 1-8. The focus of this program is to provide exciting educational opportunities while expanding the students' knowledge of the world around them.

**Class Dates:** The classes will be held on three consecutive **Tuesdays: January 11th, January 18th, and January 25th from 3:45 p.m. to 4:45 p.m.** If school is canceled for the day due to bad weather or any other unforeseen emergency, the Enrichment Program will also be canceled. We have one make-up day planned for **February 1**, if necessary. There are no refunds for cancelled classes.

**The cost is \$30 per child.** After completing the registration form online, you must send in a check to the school office made payable to "**St. Ignatius PTO**" and put on the envelope "Attention: After School Enrichment-Stephanie Kramer & JoAnna Brougham". You may write one check per family (\$30 x number of children registered). In the memo please include all of the students' names that are registered. Registration including payment is due by **November 23**. No exceptions.

**Confirmation:** Every effort is made to grant students their first class choice. If a class has enrollment greater than the maximum available space, selection will be done on a random basis. It is important to pick three different classes on the registration form. If the same class is picked for all three choices and is full, a student will be placed where there is a class opening. While rare, if the student does not get any of their three choices, you will be sent a selection of the remaining class openings. All students will receive final confirmation by December 17th.

**After School:** When the regular school day ends, students will be sent to their assigned enrichment classroom. Please send a note to your child's teacher informing of his/her participation in ASE. If your child cannot attend enrichment class, but is present at school on that day, please inform the school office or one of the coordinators. We will mark your child(ren) off the attendance list. Parents must inform the child(ren)'s teacher of attendance at ASE.

**Pick-Up:** Parents are asked to promptly pick up their child(ren) outside the main school office doors at 4:45 pm. Please do not enter the school building as COVID-19 protocols are in place. Your child(ren) will be escorted to the sidewalk outside the office doors. Students will not be allowed to walk through the parking lot without an adult. Children not picked up on time will be taken to After-School Care.

**Discipline:** It is expected that all instructors and volunteers will be treated politely and with respect. Any student participating in the program will follow the St. Ignatius School conduct policy. If any child is disruptive or behaving inappropriately, he/she will be asked to leave with no refund given.
