In my office there has been a sign hanging on my wall since I began my job in 2007. It reads:


"If you have troubles, come in and tell me about them. If you don't, come in and tell me how you do it!".

#### **COUNSELLOR CORNER**



At the beginning of 2020 many people were struggling, however I didn't feel the effects until 2021. We had been struggling to purchase a home during an inflated housing crisis, multiple deaths of loved ones and unanswered prayers. When life hits you hard it's easy to guestion "where is God?" and "what is He doing?".

Someone brought to my attention the topic of being in a wilderness season. This resonated with me, as I was in that season in my life. I believe God calls each of us to endure wilderness seasons over

the course of our lives and how we respond matters. As I dug deeper, these lessons I have learned.

You are in a time of God's protection - Learning obedience, character development, humility, self-discovery, cleansing and purifying, season of strengthening, revelation and awakening. A season that leads us into the promise of becoming more like Christ

God doesn't take the pain away and HE does give you something to hold on to and offers hope in the midst of the struggle. This insight may make all the difference. 
