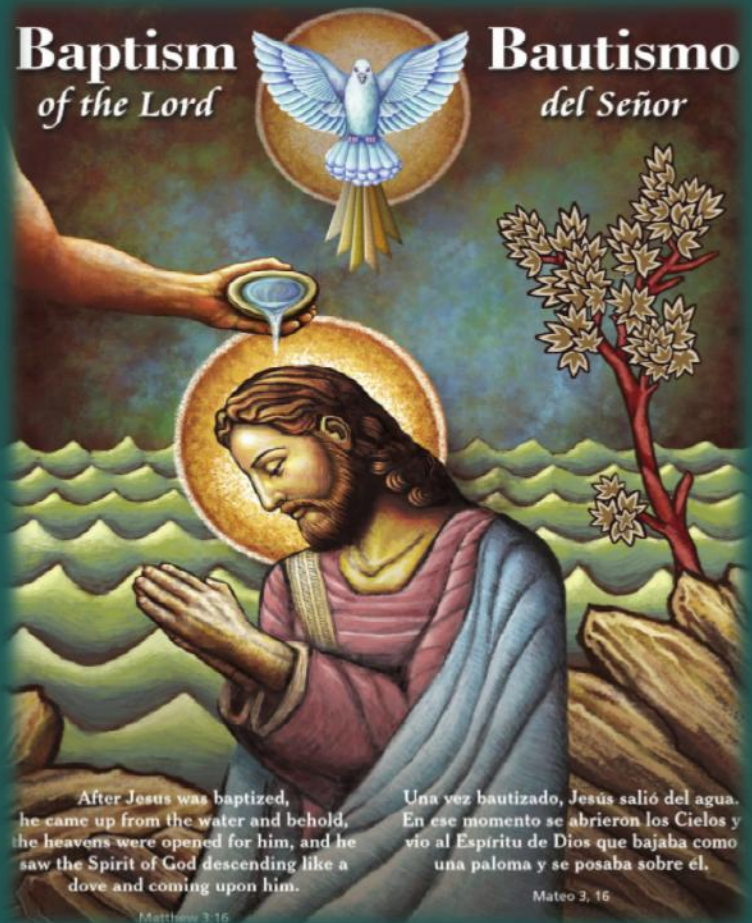

2ND SUNDAY—ORDINARY TIME



We call this period of the liturgical year “Ordinary Time,” but this time after Christmas is not ordinary at all, for it is now that we learn about the first days of Jesus’ public life. In today’s Gospel, John testifies that the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus when John baptized him, meaning that the Holy Spirit joined in Christ’s entire mission.

Both Isaiah and John the Baptist were blessed with the eyes of faith, the wisdom to understand what they were seeing, and the will to proclaim it. Despite years in exile in Babylon, Isaiah saw the day when God’s salvation would come to the whole world. John saw something like a dove descend upon Jesus and realized that this was the Holy Spirit.

Seven times in the first chapter of his Gospel John uses a form of the word “testify” to describe what John the Baptist has come to do. The word suggests a witness in a courtroom. Much later, when Jesus is called before Pilate to testify, he tells Pilate that he has come into the world “to testify to the truth” (John 18:37). John’s Gospel itself is his testimony of the Lamb of God, willingly led to slaughter to take away the sin of the world.

Baptized with the same Holy Spirit, we too are able to see with the eyes of faith: to recognize the Lord in the Word of God we hear proclaimed, in the Eucharist we share, and in each other and in our world. Do we recognize the Lord as Isaiah and John did?

To be a Christian is to be called to testify to the truth we know in the Lord. May we be conscious of that divine presence as we join in Christ’s mission during our own ordinary time.

Question of the Week

How can I be a better witness to the truth, to what I see with eyes of faith?

2° DOMINGO—TIEMPO ORDINARIO



Llamamos a este período del año litúrgico “Tiempo Ordinario”, pero este tiempo después de la Navidad no tiene nada de ordinario, porque es ahora cuando conocemos los primeros días de la vida pública de Jesús. En el Evangelio de hoy, Juan testifica que el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre Jesús cuando Juan lo bautizó, lo que significa que el Espíritu Santo se unió a toda la misión de Cristo.

Tanto Isaías como Juan el Bautista fueron bendecidos con los ojos de la fe, la sabiduría para comprender lo que estaban viendo y la voluntad para proclamarlo. A pesar de los años de exilio en Babilonia, Isaías vio el día en que la salvación de Dios vendría a todo el mundo. Juan vio algo como una paloma descender sobre Jesús y se dio cuenta de que este era el Espíritu Santo.

Siete veces en el primer capítulo de su Evangelio Juan usa una forma de la palabra “testificar” para describir lo que Juan el Bautista ha venido a hacer. La palabra sugiere un testigo en un tribunal. Mucho más tarde, cuando Jesús es llamado ante Pilato para testificar, le dice a Pilato que ha venido al mundo “para dar testimonio de la verdad” (Juan 18:37). El mismo Evangelio de Juan es su testimonio del Cordero de Dios, llevado voluntariamente al matadero para quitar el pecado del mundo.

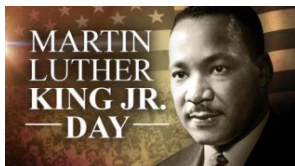
Bautizados con el mismo Espíritu Santo, también nosotros somos capaces de ver con los ojos de la fe: reconocer al Señor en la Palabra de Dios que escuchamos proclamada, en la Eucaristía que compartimos, y en los demás y en nuestro mundo. ¿Reconocemos al Señor como lo hicieron Isaías y Juan?

Ser cristiano es ser llamado a dar testimonio de la verdad que conocemos en el Señor. Que seamos conscientes de esa presencia divina al unirnos a la misión de Cristo durante nuestro propio tiempo ordinario.
