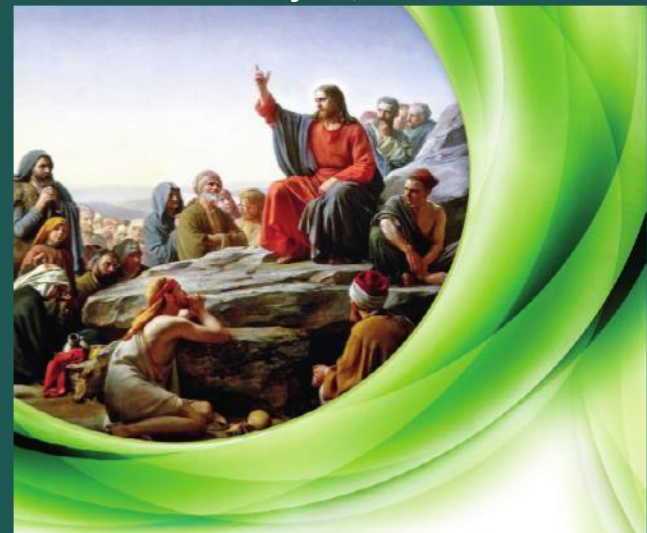

4TH SUNDAY—ORDINARY TIME



Ordinary Time gives us the opportunity to focus on the ordinary aspects of our faith and realize their continuity through history.

Time and time again, a people and their leaders fall away from the ideals of God’s covenant with humanity. Selfishness or arrogance, fear or hate, sin or evil lead people to turn toward self-preservation or self-aggrandizement. It happened in Zephaniah’s day under Assyrian influence. It happened in Jesus’ day under Roman influence. It can happen in ours.

The Beatitudes can turn us back to living right. Jesus had just called his disciples and traveled with them around Galilee, healing the sick and proclaiming the gospel, as we heard last Sunday. Soon he was drawing huge crowds, people eager to hear the words of the prophets come alive in their presence. But now, he elevates his message. Literally, for he ascends a mountain (not named, but apparently one of significance), symbolizing his authority and his closeness to God. He will go on to teach dozens of lessons—we will hear more over the next few Sundays—but he begins by teaching the people how to live.

Poverty of spirit and meekness, righteousness and mercy, peacemaking and purity of heart can do this by shifting the focus away from ourselves and onto others. Empathy teaches us to show mercy, to make peace, to work for justice, to be humble. The kingdom of heaven awaits those who are empathetic.

Question of the Week

For whom do I find it difficult to have empathy? How can I strengthen my empathy toward those who are not like me?

4° DOMINGO—TIEMPO ORDINARIO



El Tiempo Ordinario nos da la oportunidad de centrarnos en los aspectos ordinarios de nuestra fe y darnos cuenta de su continuidad a lo largo de la historia.

Una y otra vez, un pueblo y sus líderes se alejan de los ideales del pacto de Dios con la humanidad. El egoísmo o la arrogancia, el miedo o el odio, el pecado o la maldad llevan a las personas a volverse hacia la auto preservación o el auto engrandecimiento. Sucedió en los días de Sofonías bajo la influencia asiria. Sucedió en los días de Jesús bajo la influencia romana. Aun puede pasar hoy en nuestro tiempo.

Las Bienaventuranzas pueden hacernos volver a vivir correctamente. Jesús acababa de llamar a sus discípulos y viajaba con ellos por Galilea, sanando a los enfermos y anunciando el evangelio, como escuchamos el domingo pasado. Pronto estaba atrayendo grandes multitudes, personas ansiosas por escuchar las palabras de los profetas - cuyas palabras se hacían vivas cobrando. Pero ahora, *eleva su mensaje*. Literalmente, porque asciende a una montaña (sin nombre, pero aparentemente significativa), que simboliza su autoridad y su cercanía a Dios. Continuará enseñando docenas de lecciones, escucharemos más en los próximos domingos, pero comienza enseñando a la gente cómo vivir.

La pobreza de espíritu y la mansedumbre, la justicia y la misericordia, la pacificación y la pureza de corazón pueden hacer esto cambiando el enfoque de nosotros mismos hacia los demás. La empatía nos enseña a ser misericordiosos, a hacer las paces, a trabajar por la justicia, a ser humildes. El reino de los cielos espera a aquellos que son empáticos.

¿Por quién me resulta difícil tener empatía? ¿Cómo puedo fortalecer mi empatía hacia aquellos que no son como yo?

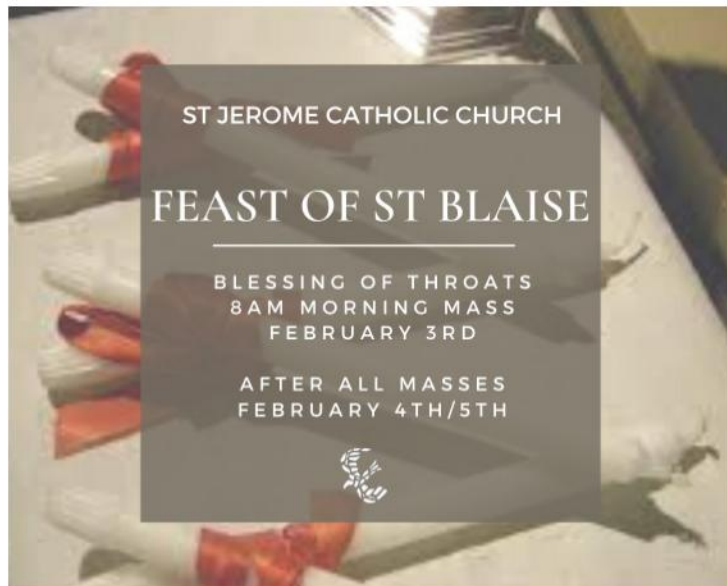
