

COME TO DAILY MASS!

This week we celebrate two special occasions. On Monday, we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. While normally celebrated on March 19 when that day falls on a Lenten Sunday the feast is transferred to the following day. And next Saturday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. All our other liturgical celebrations this week are Lenten weekday Masses.

"COME HOME TO GOD'S MERCY" Tuesday Night Confessions During Lent

Several years ago, Bishop McManus requested that every parish in the Diocese offer opportunities for Catholics to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance; confessions) on Lenten Tuesdays between 7:00 pm and 8:00 pm. We continue this practice. Lent is a wonderful time to receive God's mercy in this extraordinary Sacrament. In addition to Saturday afternoons, we will be offering confessions on Lenten Tuesday evenings.

GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE IN LENT

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows: Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on all the Fridays of Lent including Good Friday of course. Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on Good Friday. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.


