4TH SUNDAY—LENT

Having reached the halfway point of Lent, we celebrate Laetare Sunday. This Latin word, pronounced lay-TAR-ray, means “rejoice.” We rejoice in the knowledge that the cross does not end in death, that Jesus’ story does not end in the tomb. The Church also celebrates the second scrutiny today, a significant step for catechumens but also an opportunity for all of us to look into our hearts for the sinful habits and tendencies we may not even see.

Today’s readings explore the theme of blindness, both literal and metaphorical. The man born literally blind receives his eyesight by Jesus’ action in the Gospel, but we also witness Samuel’s metaphorical blindness to David’s fitness for kingship, the Pharisees’ blindness to Jesus’ holiness, and even the willful blindness of the blind man’s parents when they are questioned.

May God’s word help us examine our own blindnesses as we welcome the light of Christ. May we “live as children of light,” as Paul told the Ephesians (5:8), opening the eyes of others and guiding them to what is good and righteous and true.

Habiendo llegado a la mitad de la Cuaresma, celebramos el domingo de Laetare. Esta palabra latina, pronunciada lay-TAR-ray, significa "regocijarse". Nos regocijamos al saber que la cruz no termina en la muerte, que la historia de Jesús no termina en la tumba. La Iglesia también celebra hoy el segundo escrutinio, un paso significativo para los catecúmenos, pero también una oportunidad para que todos nosotros busquemos en nuestros corazones los hábitos y tendencias pecaminosas que quizás ni siquiera veamos.

Las lecturas de hoy exploran el tema de la ceguera, tanto literal como metafóricamente. El hombre que nació literalmente ciego recibe su vista por la acción de Jesús en el Evangelio, pero también somos testigos de la ceguera metafórica de Samuel a la idoneidad de David para el reinado, la ceguera de los fariseos a la santidad de Jesús, e incluso la ceguera deliberada de los padres del hombre ciego cuando son cuestionados.

Que la palabra de Dios nos ayude a examinar nuestras propias cegueras mientras damos la bienvenida a la luz de Cristo. Que podamos "vivir como hijos de luz", como dijo Pablo a los Efesios (5:8), abriendo los ojos de los demás y guiándolos hacia lo que es bueno, justo y verdadero.
