THE MOST HOLY TRINITY



We come together today to celebrate our triune God, one God and yet three persons. The mystery of the Trinity is a mystery we cannot hope to truly comprehend with our limited human intelligence and from our limited human perspective. But this makes perfect sense. A God who can be fully explained is a God who is less than our intelligence.

“The LORD is a merciful and gracious God,” which we hear in the first reading, are not the words of Moses or of any other person, but God’s own words to Moses.

From the great and wonderful things God did for the Chosen People to sending the Son to bestowing the Spirit to be with us always, God has constantly treated us with infinite mercy and grace.

Throughout the Old Testament God forgives the Chosen People for their unfaithfulness, for the many times they turn away from God, for their sinfulness. God the Son was born into this world, a part of humankind, and chose to sacrifice his life to save us all. Jesus personifies that infinite mercy, given by God to us in two ways. The Son was given to us in the Incarnation, sharing in our humanity, and he was also given over to death on the cross, redeeming us from our sinfulness. Our God is a forgiving God. We see this in the New Testament, in the way that Jesus treats sinners in the Gospels, leading to his willingness to sacrifice his life for sinners. His forgiveness is not distant or impersonal. He gets to know sinners intimately, which leads to him loving them more deeply, which leads to forgiveness that is true and real. We would do well to strive to do the same. Listening to God’s word, let us reflect on how God’s grace and mercy have changed us.

Question of the Week

What concrete actions can I take to be a more forgiving person? Can I overcome my insistence that those whom I forgive be deserving of it?

LA SANTISIMA TRINIDAD

Pero esto tiene mucho sentido. Un Dios que puede ser

completamente explicado es un Dios que es inferior a nuestra inteligencia.

“Jehová es un Dios misericordioso y clemente”, que escuchamos en la primera lectura, no son las palabras de Moisés ni de ninguna otra persona, sino las propias palabras de Dios a Moisés.

Desde las cosas grandes y maravillosas que Dios hizo por el Pueblo Elegido hasta el envío del Hijo y el otorgamiento del Espíritu para que esté siempre con nosotros, Dios nos ha tratado constantemente con infinita misericordia y gracia.

A lo largo del Antiguo Testamento Dios perdona al Pueblo Elegido por su infidelidad, por las muchas veces que se aleja de Dios, por su pecaminosidad. Dios Hijo nació en este mundo, parte de la humanidad, y eligió sacrificar su vida para salvarnos a todos. Jesús personifica esa misericordia infinita, dada por Dios a nosotros de dos maneras. El Hijo nos fue dado en la Encarnación, participando de nuestra humanidad, y también fue entregado a la muerte en la cruz, redimiéndonos de nuestra pecaminosidad. Nuestro Dios es un Dios que perdona. Vemos esto en el Nuevo Testamento, en la forma en que Jesús trata a los pecadores en los Evangelios, lo que lo lleva a estar dispuesto a sacrificar su vida por los pecadores. Su perdón no es distante ni impersonal. Llega a conocer íntimamente a los pecadores, lo que lo lleva a amarlos más profundamente, lo que lo lleva a un perdón verdadero y real. Haríamos bien en esforzarnos por hacer lo mismo.

Escuchando la palabra de Dios, reflexionemos sobre cómo nos ha cambiado la gracia y la misericordia de Dios.
