#### 27TH SUNDAY—ORDINARY TIME



Like the last few Sundays, the readings today speak of a vineyard. The vineyard we are invited to contemplate today is not just a large field planted with vines, but our very home in the Lord. The fruit it produces is not just grapes or wine, but the kingdom of God made manifest in our world. From

the first reading through the psalm and on to the Gospel, we are afforded the chance to consider the wonderful vineyard that God created for us and what has befallen it over the course of centuries.

Impressively built and expensively furnished, It must have been a beautiful vineyard attracting tenants who wanted the finer things in life. They saw the vineyard and they envied its owner. They probably felt that they deserved it and its bountiful harvest. After all, they'd worked all year while the owner traveled far and wide. Who did this absentee owner and lowly servants think they were to take away all that they had produced? They wanted it all for themselves. So they fought to keep it, escalating their fight until they saw their opportunity to keep it forever. Now, it seems nonsensical for the landowner to keep sending servants to the murderous tenants. Who would send more? Then who would send the person most precious to them in the whole world? But God persists in giving even the most incorrigible sinners second and even third chances. For God sent the Son not to be lauded by saints, but to save sinners. It is sinners who get opportunity after opportunity to repent and choose good. Even after they killed the Son, God does not put the murderers to a wretched death, as the chief priests and elders who heard this parable assumed. God always offers mercy, even to those who show none. May God's word inspire us to bear good fruit in the vineyard that is our world.

### 27° DOMINGO—TIEMPO ORDINARIO



Como los últimos domingos, las lecturas de hoy hablan de un viñedo. La viña que estamos invitados a contemplar hoy no es sólo un gran campo plantado de vides, sino nuestro propio hogar en el Señor. El fruto que produce no son sólo uvas o vino, sino el reino de Dios

manifestado en nuestro mundo. Desde la primera lectura hasta el salmo y el Evangelio, se nos brinda la oportunidad de considerar la maravillosa viña que Dios creó para nosotros y lo que le ha sucedido a lo largo de los siglos.

Impresionantemente construido y costosamente amueblado, debe haber sido un hermoso viñedo que atraía a inquilinos que querían las cosas buenas de la vida. Vieron la viña y envidiaron a su dueño. Probablemente sintieron que se lo merecían y su abundante cosecha. Después de todo, habían trabajado todo el año mientras el propietario viajaba por todas partes. ¿Quién pensaban que eran este dueño ausente y estos humildes sirvientes para quitarles todo lo que habían producido? Lo querían todo para ellos. Así que lucharon para conservarlo, intensificando su lucha hasta que vieron la oportunidad de conservarlo para siempre. Ahora bien, parece absurdo que el terrateniente siga enviando sirvientes a los inquilinos asesinos. ¿Quién enviaría más? Entonces, ¿quién les enviaría a la persona más preciada del mundo? Pero Dios persiste en dar incluso a los pecadores más incorregibles una segunda e incluso una tercera oportunidad. Porque Dios envió al Hijo no para ser alabado por los santos, sino para salvar a los pecadores. Son los pecadores quienes tienen oportunidad tras oportunidad de arrepentirse y elegir el bien. Incluso después de que mataron al Hijo, Dios no condena a los asesinos a una muerte miserable, como asumieron los principales sacerdotes y los ancianos que escucharon esta parábola. Dios siempre ofrece misericordia, incluso a aquellos que no la muestran. Que la palabra de Dios nos inspire a dar buenos frutos en la viña que es nuestro mundo.
