DR. RICHARD ROBBINS is director of choral activities at the University of Minnesota Duluth and chorus master of the Duluth Superior Symphony Orchestra. His experience with young voices includes directing choirs at Houston's prestigious High School for the Performing and Visual Arts, where he conducted singers in multiple engagements with the Houston Symphony and the Grammy Foundation. He has also directed choirs of changing and changed-voice tenors and basses for the Lake Superior Youth Chorus and the Houston Boychoir, and has presented on a range of topics related to young singers for the National Catholic Educational Association and the American Choral Directors Association.
