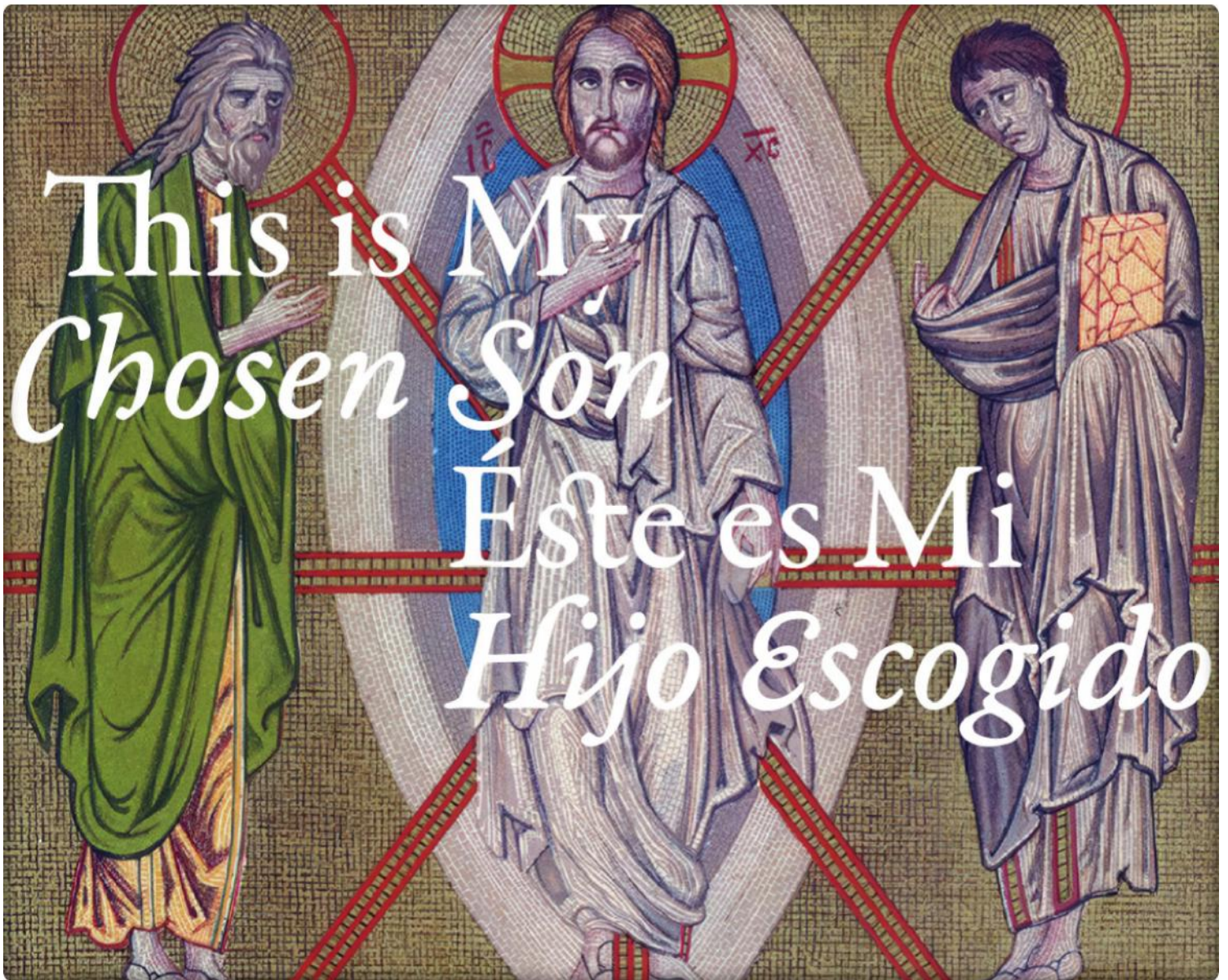

The story of the Transfiguration of Jesus in the Luke's Gospel this week is similar to the ones in Matthew and Mark. One difference I noticed in Luke's version is that Jesus does not tell the three disciples to keep it secret. It seems they decided on their own not to tell anyone.

One reason may be what they heard. While Matthew and Mark just say that Jesus spoke with Moses and Elijah, Luke is more specific: They "spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem" (9:31). Jesus had just said that he would suffer, die, and be raised from the dead in Luke 9:22. They probably hoped he was just telling them the worst that could happen, not what really would happen. So hearing it from Moses and Elijah as well as from Jesus was too much for them.

This is where we come in. The apostles were afraid to face the coming passion and death of Jesus. I think we are like them in that we suffer more in anticipating what would hurt us than we do going through it. That is where faith can help. In faith, we hear Jesus tell us not to fear, as he often told his disciples. We know that Jesus suffered on the cross, so he knows what suffering is. And faith tells us that he is with us even when the suffering is the result of our own sins. After all, he himself suffered because of our sins. So have faith!

La historia de la Transfiguración de Jesús en el Evangelio de Lucas de esta semana es semejante a las de Mateo y Marcos. Una diferencia que noté en la versión de Lucas es que Jesús no les dice a los tres discípulos que lo mantengan en secreto. Parece que decidieron por su cuenta no decírselo a nadie.

Una razón puede ser lo que oyeron. Mientras que Mateo y Marcos solo dicen que Jesús habló con Moisés y Elías, Lucas es más específico: "Y hablaban de la muerte que le esperaba en Jerusalén" (9,31). Jesús acababa de decir que sufriría, moriría y resucitaría de entre los muertos en Lucas 9,22. Seguro esperaban que solo les estuviera diciendo lo peor que podría suceder, no lo que realmente sucedería. Así que oír lo mismo de Moisés y Elías también era demasiado para ellos.

Aquí es donde entramos nosotros. Los apóstoles tenían miedo de enfrentar la pasión y muerte de Jesús que estaba por venir. Creo que somos semejantes a ellos en el sentido de que sufrimos más al anticipar lo que nos haría daño que al atravesarlo. Ahí es donde la fe puede ayudar. Con la fe, escuchamos a Jesús decirnos que no tengamos miedo, como le decía a menudo a sus discípulos. Sabemos que Jesús sufrió en la cruz, así que Él sabe lo que es el sufrimiento. Y la fe nos dice que está con nosotros incluso cuando el sufrimiento es el resultado de nuestros propios pecados. Al fin de cuentas, Él mismo sufrió por nuestros pecados. Así que, ¡ten fe!

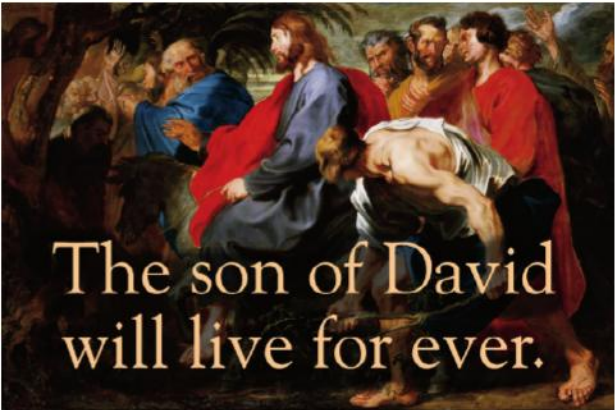

Fr. Binh T. Ta, CSsR, is a Redemptorist missionary of the Denver Province currently assigned as Pastor at St. Gerard Catholic Church. In 1980 he and his family immigrated to the United States, resettling in Texas. Five years later, in response to God's love, he joined the Redemptorists. During his religious formation, he was sent to minister among refugees in the Philippines. Upon his return, he professed perpetual vows and soon later was ordained a priest. He completed his study for Bachelor of Arts in 1986, Master of Divinity in 1993, and Doctor of Ministry in Intercultural Spirituality in 2009. Fr. Binh's ministerial experiences are richly varied, including parish ministry, young adult ministry as community organizer, admin. leadership, religious/priestly training as formation director, university campus chaplain. He hopes and desires to continue practicing and sharing Jesus Christ's Gospel with people of diverse cultures.
