PASTOR'S DESK

27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (CYCLE C) | RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY OCTOBER 5, 2025

Earlier last week, members of the parish pastoral councils of St. Columbkille and St. Augustine gathered to reflect and learn more about the Beacons of Light initiative underway across the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. More specifically, we gathered to understand how the concept of "synodality" is to apply to leadership in the Church, both on the archdiocesan and parish level. Joining us to present and help us think about synodality at the local level was Fr. Tom DiFolco. A priest of our archdiocese for more than 40 years, Fr. DiFolco works at the Center for Parish Vitality at the chancery offices in Cincinnati.

At the meeting, Fr. DiFolco first gave a working definition of the word "synodality," as follows....

"Synodality is the walking together of Christians with Christ and toward God's kingdom, in union with all humanity. Orientated toward mission, synodality involves gathering at all levels of the Church for mutual listening, dialogue, and community discernment. It also involves reaching consensus as an expression of Christ rendering Himself present, He who is alive in the Spirit. Furthermore, it consists in reaching decisions according to a differentiated understanding of co-responsibility, dialogue, mutual understanding, and discernment."

(From the final document on the Synod on Synodality, September 24, 2024)

To be sure, there's much to unpack in that definition, and even more to consider in applying synodality to the leadership structure of our parish family. While upholding Church law and the teaching authority of the Magisterium, synodality emphasizes leadership as a spiritual practice. At the parish level, this means speaking and listening in ways that allow God's spirit to be evident and to guide us. Further, it allows parish leadership members the opportunity to have conversations that are as much spiritual (i.e., in the Spirit) as they are practical. When rooted in the Holy Spirit, better conversations make for better decisions. I thank Fr. DiFolco for his expertise and experience, and I am grateful for the many blessings and talents of parishioners who offer their time, talent, and treasure in ways that bring others to God and God to themselves.



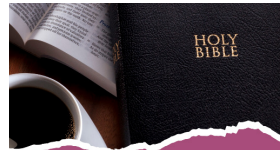

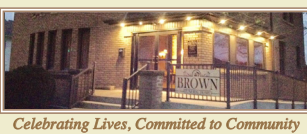
