To go along with our letters in class I have been showing them a program called Letters Alive. You can find them on YouTube. It features a Zookeeper and Gertie the Giraffe and they teach the kids different animals that start with the letter. They introduce the letters and the sound and read them a story. The kids love it! And they learn some cool facts about the animals.

This week we worked on numbers up to 5. We worked with double sided counters, one side red and the other yellow. This helped us start to work on different combinations of numbers that when put together equal 5. This is something you could do at home. Draw a 5 frame on a piece of paper and give them two different colored objects. What different combinations make 5?
