PASTOR'S DESK

28TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (CYCLE C) OCTOBER 12, 2025

Folks at St. Augustine in Waynesville have cabbage rolls and sauerkraut on their minds! In the time I've been here, I've learned a lot about the festival that draws people from all over Ohio to sample cabbage and other foods that are offered at the Ohio Sauerkraut Festival. I've also come to learn about the many volunteers from St. Augustine who come together and help raise funds for the parish through the now-famous cabbage roll sales. Their willingness to organize and help with the fundraiser is a sign of their support not only for their parish and wider community, but also their thanksgiving to God, who is the source of all blessings. I thank them as I thank all those in our Parish Family who demonstrate gratitude through their generous offering of volunteerism and funding of our churches.

Gratitude lies at the heart of the Gospel this weekend (Lk 17:11-19). On the face of it, the parable in Luke's Gospel is pretty straightforward. Ten lepers. Ten healings. But only one thank-you. Jesus commends the actions of the one leper who said "thank you." And by the way, he was one you'd least expect – the Samaritan "foreigner." But if we knew the context of this account, we'd know that this Samaritan would be thankful for more than a cure to his skin disease. Back then, leprosy was considered not just as a disease but as a punishment for sin. Consequently, the leper was "persona non-grata" to the faith community. This was the primary reason that lepers were forced to live outside their towns and away from the general faith community. They were forced to wear bells around their necks so that other people would know they were unclean and left to beg in order to survive. Talk about good reasons to be thankful!

If you were asked the question, "How's your faith?," how would you respond? And even before responding, what criteria would you use *in order* to respond? To be sure, there are plenty of possible answers. But part of any valid response would need to involve gratitude. In addition, considering that the word "eucharist" means "thanksgiving," the response would also need to connect our Catholic faith with the Mass, the source and summit of the Church's life.

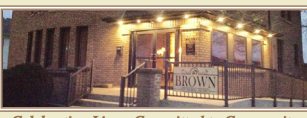

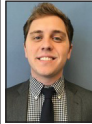
