This week we...

Reading- We read a story titled *The Dog That Dug for Dinosaurs* which was a Non-Fiction story about a girl and her dog named Tray who found fossils in England. The second graders deepened their understanding facts vs. opinions in a story. Lastly, the kiddos worked on spelling/phonics with words that have oo as in book.

Math- We keep measuring away! We've measured our feet, we've measured our classroom and we've even measured similar objects (that have different lengths) and learned how to graph the measured data. As your child what the difference is between a ruler, a yardstick and a measuring tape. See what they know!

Science and Social Studies- We are nearing our lessons about liquid but are finishing up about solids. Today, we partnered up and compared/categorized solid objects that have the same properties.
